* Since March 21, 1956, mines not receiving aid under the Emergency Gold Mining Assistance Act have been allowed to sell their gold to private residents and non-residents, either for export or for safekeeping in Canada. Such sales, commencing in April, are now included in the figures for New Gold Production Available for Export.

The above statistics of exports do not include defence equipment or supplies transferred by Canada to North Atlantic Treaty countries under the Defence Appropriation Act, which were as follows: Calendar year 1950, \$56,750,000; Calendar year 1951, \$109,061,583; Calendar year 1952, \$100,900,000; Calendar year 1953, \$181,970,000; Calendar year 1954, \$202,400,000; Calendar year 1955, \$165,922,000; 1st Quarter 1956, \$20,100,000 (subject to revision); 2nd Quarter 1956, \$31,222,000 (subject to revision).
