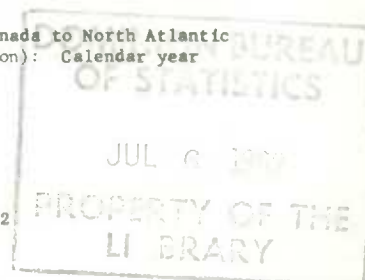

\*Note: The new "Export Commodity Classification" replaced the former "Statistical Classification—Exports" as a framework for compiling export statistics with effect from January 1, 1961. This bulletin will continue in 1962 to present statistics arranged as closely as possible according to the groups and sub-groups of the former classification (Tables 1 and 4) in order to facilitate comparisons with totals for earlier years.

It is not possible to obtain from the "Export Commodity Classification" all the totals presented in this bulletin for 1960 and earlier years. In a few cases, former sub-groups had to be deleted and combined with others; in the main group "Chemicals and allied products", all former sub-groups were replaced by five new sub-groups because satisfactory conversion to the old framework is not feasible. In other main groups asterisks are used to indicate those sub-groups where the conversion of 1962 and 1961 statistics to the earlier framework is only approximate.

A summary of exports according to the new "Export Commodity Classification" now appears as Table 6 on page 8. Comparable statistics are not yet available for periods prior to 1961.
