ON TRAVELLERS' VEHICLE PERMITS MAY, 1957.

Foreign vehicles entering Canada on travellers' vehicle permits totalled 185,817 in May, an increase of 14 per cent or 23,429 more crossing than in the same month of 1956. All provinces recorded an increase with the exception of Alberta and entries into Nova Scotia and Newfoundland direct by vessel. Cumulative entries for the first five months were 9 per cent heavier than in the same period of the previous year.

NOTE: Travellers' vehicle permits are issued to foreign vehicles which remain in Canada longer than 48 hours or which travel beyond the jurisdiction of the port of entry. (Thus a motorist who intends to leave the country at a point other than that of entry must apply for a traveller's vehicle permit). Figures shown above refer almost exclusively to automobiles. They include a small number of taxis, motorcycles and bicycles, but exclude buses, trucks and other commercial vehicles. Data for current month are subject to revision. Entries into Canada via Newfoundland and Nova Scotia are by ship.
