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## VOLUME OF HIGHWAY TRAFFIC ENTERING CANADA ON TRAVELLERS' VEHICLE PERMITS <br> JUNE, 1957

Memorandum

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A new record for the month of June was established in the number of foreign vehicles entering Canada on travellers ${ }^{\circ}$ vehicle permits. Entries totalled 332,000, an increase of between 3 and 4 per cent over the previous record for the month in 1956. Cumulative entries for the first six months show an increase of 7 per cent or 54,600 more wiries than the same period of last year.

NOTE: Travellers' vehicle permits are issued to foreign vehicles which remain in Canada longer than 48 hours or which travel beyond the jurisdiction of the port of entry. (Thus a motorist who intends to leave the country at a point other than that of entry must apply for a traveller's vehicle permit). Figures shown above refer almost exclusively to automobiles. They include a small number of taxis, motorcycles and bicycles, but exclude buses, trucks and other commercial vehicles. Data for current month are subject to revision. Vehicles entering Canada via Newfoundland and Nova Scotia are by vessel.
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
