## VOLUNT OF HIGHWAY TRAFIIC ENTERING CANADA ON TRAVELLERS' VEHICLE PEFMI'TS <br> JULY, 1957

Foreign vehicles entering Canada on travellers vehicle permits totalled 543,995 in July, an increase of 0.4 per cent or 2,280 more crossings than in the same month of 1956 . Cumulative entries for the first seven months were 4 per cent hesvier than the the same period of the previous year.
