VOLUME OF HIGHWAY TRAFFIC ENTERING CANADA ON TRAVELLERS' VEHICLE PERMITS AUGUST, 1957

A new record for the month of August was established in the number of foreign vehicles entering Canada on travellers' vehicle permits. The new record of 574,926 entries represents an increase of 9 per cent of 48,188 more than the same month of 1956 and 28,741 more than the previous record established in 1953. Entries for Labour day week-end were

NOTE: Travellers' vehicle permits are issued to foreign vehicles which remain in Canada longer than 48 hours or which travel beyond the jurisdiction of the port of entry. (Thus a motorist who intends to leave the country at a point other than that of entry must apply for a traveller's vehicle permit). Figures shown above refer almost exclusively to automobiles. They include a small number of taxis, motorcycles and bicycles, but exclude buses, trucks and other commercial vehicles. Data for current months are subject to revision. Vehicles entering Canada via Newfoundland and Nova Scotia are by vessel.
