

## ON TRAVELLERS' VEHICLE PERMITS NOVEMBER, 1958

Price \$1.00 per year 10 cents per copy

The number of foreign vehicles entering Canada on travellers vehicle permits in November advanced 6 per cent due to the change in procedure at certain ports in New Brunswick. The effect of this change is estimated at an increase of around 7,000 entries. Data comparable with last year would show a decrease of between 5 and 7 per cent instead of a 6 per cent increase for the month. Cumulative data adjusted for the change of procedure would show a decline of about 1 per cent instead of 0.1 per cent.

NOTE: - Travellers' vehicle permits are issued to foreign vehicles which remain in Canada longer than 48 hours or which travel beyond the jurisdiction of the port of entry. (Thus a motorist who intends to leave the country at a point other than that of entry must apply for a traveller's vehicle permit). Figures shown above refer almost exclusively to automobiles. They include a small number of taxis, motorcycles and bicycles, but exclude buses, trucks and other commercial vehicles. Data for current month are subject to revision. Entries into Canada via Newfoundland and Nova Scotia are by vessel.
