VOLUME OF HIGHWAY TRAFFIC ENTERING CANADA ON TRAVELLERS' VEHICLE PERMITS MARCH, 1959

Foreign vehicles entering Canada on travellers' vehicle permits in Marchy totalled 84,444, an increase of 5,838 or approximately 7 per cent. Data adjusted for the change of procedure at certain New Brunswick ports are estimated at an increase of around 1,100 or roughly 1 per cent. Cumulative data for the first quarter adjusted for change of procedure indicate a decline of about 3 per cent instead of a gain of 5.6 per cent.

Travellers' vehicle permits are issued to motorists who intend to leave the country at a port other than that of entry or remain longer than 48 hours. Figures refer chiefly to automobiles and include a small number of taxis, motorcycles and bicycles but exclude buses, trucks and other commercial vehicles. Entries via Newfoundland and Nova Scotia are by vessel. Data for current month are subject to revision.
