VOLUME OF HIGHWAY TRAFFIC ENTERING CANADA
ON TRAVELLERS' VEHICLE PERMITS
JUNE, 1959

Foreign vehicles entering Canada on travellers' vehicle persits in June, numbered 315,468, a gain of 8,639 or nearly 3 per cent more than the corresponding month of 1958. Data adjusted for the change of procedure at certain New Brunswick ports indicate a decline of about 1,200 or less than half of one per cent. Cumula tive data for the first half of the year adjusted for the change of procedure indicate a decrease of nearly 42,200 or about 5 per cent instead of a gain of 613 crossings as shown below.

Travellers' vehicle permits are issued to motorists who intend to leave the country at a port other than that of entry or remain longer than 48 hours. Figures refer chiefly to automobiles and include a small number of taxis, motorcycles and bicycles but exclude buses, trucks and other commercial vehicles. Entries via Newfoundland and Nova Scotia are by vessel. Data for current month are subject to revision.
