VOLUME OF HIGHWAY TRAFFIC ENTERING CANADA ON TRAVELLERS' VEHICLE PERMITS SEPTEMBER, 1959

In September there was an increase of 51,594 vehicles or 20.5 per cent in the number of foreign vehicles entering Canada on travellers' vehicle permits to a total of 303,562. This sharp rise which was widely distributed by provinces was presumably partly a reflection of the later date of Labour Day this year. There was a cumulative rise of 3.9 per cent in entries in the period from January to September but the rise in comparable traffic was less than this if adjustment is made for a change in procedure at certain ports in New Brunswick which affected the data before September.

With this issue this publication is being temporarily discontinued because of the effects of a change in the procedure of the Department of National Revenue in dealing with the entry of non-resident vehicles. Publication is expected to be resumed when a new form of presentation is developed for showing comparable monthly statistics of traffic.
