Foreign vehicles entering Canada on traveller's vehicle permits in April totalled 86,300, a decrease of 1 per cent from the same month last year. Consolidated data for the two months of March and April show a gain of 11 per cent which is not influenced by the changing date of Easter.

(Thus a motorist who intends to leave the country at a point other than that of entry must apply for a traveller's vehicle permit). Figures shown above refer almost exclusively to automobiles. They include a small number of taxis, motorcycles and bioycles, but exclude buses. trucks and ther commercial vehicles.
