## VOLUME OF HIGHJAY TRAFFIC MTT RING CANADA <br> ON TRIVELIER'S VEHICLE PERMITS <br> NOVEMER 1952

Foreign vehicles entering Canada on traveller's vehicle permits in November totalled 88, 048 , an ircrease of 16 per cent over the previous year and a new record for the month. Nearly all regions shared in the advance. Cumulative totals for the first eleven montins were two per cent higher than in the year before.

They include a small number of taxis, motorcycles and bicycles, but exclude buses, trucks and other comercial vehicles. Data for current month are subject to revision. Entries into Canada via Newfoundland and Nova Scotia are by ship.
