## ON TRAVEILTER'S VEHICLE PERNITS

## LAY, 1952

Foreign vehicles entering Canada on traveller's vehicle perraits in liay totalled 179,400, an increase of $2 l$ per cent ower the previous year and a new record for the month. The rate of gain was u:iform throughout most of the country, ranging between 20 and 33 per cent in all regions except the Atlantic Provinces and the Yukon Territory. Fivemonth totals were up 14 per cent.

NOTE: Traveller's vehicle permits are issued to foreign vehicles which remain in Canada longer than 48 hours or which travel beyond the jurisdiction of the port of entry. (Thus a motorist who intends to leave the country at a point other than that of entry must apply for a traveller's vehicle permit). Figures shown above refer almost exclusively to automobiles. They include a small number of texis, motorcycles and bicycles, but exclude buses, trucks and other commercial vehicles.
