VOLUME OF HIGHWAY TRAFFIC ENTERING CANADA
ON TRAVELLER'S VEHICLE PERMITS
SEPTEMBER, 1952

Foreign vehicles entering Canada on traveller's vehicle permits in September totalled 232,600, or 17 per cent less than in September of last year. As Labour Day occurred this year on Monday September 1st, most visitors for the holiday entered Canada in August and helped to raise the August traffic to the highest total for any month on record. Nine month totals were three per cent higher than in the year before.

NOTE: Traveller's vehicle permits are issued to foreign vehicles which remain in Canada longer than 48 hours or which travel beyond the jurisdiction of the port of entry. (Thus a motorist who intends to leave the country at a point other than that of entry must apply for a traveller's vehicle permit.) Figures shown above refer almost exclusively to automobiles. They include a small number of taxis, motorcycles and bicycles, but exclude buses, trucks and other commercial vehicles.
