ON TRAVELLER'S VEHICLE PERMITS SEPTEMBER, 1953

Foreign vehicles entering Canada on traveller's vehicle permits in September totalled 305,200, or 31 per cent more than in September of last year. As Labour Day occurred on Monday, September 1st, 1952, most visitors for the holiday entered Canada in August of that year, whereas, in 1953 the great inflow of American holiday-makers is recorded in September. If August and September are combined, 84,500 more vehicles entered Canada on traveller's vehicle permits in 1953 representing an increase of 11 per cent. Cumulative data for the first nine months were 9 per cent higher than in the year before.

NOTE: Traveller's vehicle permits are issued to foreign vehicles which remain in Canada longer than 48 hours or which travel beyond the jurisdiction of the port of entry. (Thus a motorist who intends to leave the country at a point other than that of entry must apply for a traveller's vehicle permit.) Figures shown above refer almost exclusively to automobiles. They include a small number of taxis, motorcycles and bicycles, but exclude buses, trucks and other commercial vehicles.
