### Sales and Purchases of Securities Between Canada and Other Countries


#### November, 1935.

Although somewhat less than in October the international trade in securities between Canada and other countries in November remained higher than in any of the months of the year previous to October. There were declines in the volumes of transactions between both Canada and the United States and Canada and Great Britain during the month. This decline in total transactions was principally in the reduced purchases. The result on the net balance of transactions was to produce a large net balance of sales as contrasted with the very small net balance of purchases in the month before. interesting characteristic of the trading in November was an increase in the international purchase and sale of stocks accompanied by a decline in the similar trade in This trade in securities between Canada and other countries was carried on through the medium of the investment dealers, stock exchanges, banks, insurance companies, trust and mortgage companies, United States branch houses, and other agencies. It constitutes one of the most important invisible items in Canada's international transactions.

Total sales were \$30,544,056 in November compared with \$31,718,584 in October while total purchases declined to \$23,066,041 from \$31,816,244 in October. Sales to the United States were \$27,714,098 in November compared with \$28,416,408 in October and purchases from the United States were only \$18,490,740 in the latter month compared with \$25,573,669 in the former. Sales to Great Britain declined to \$2,501,749 in November from \$3,056,239 in October while purchases declined to \$4,065,207 from \$5,646,187.

For the first eleven months of 1935 sales of securities outside of Canada totalled \$265,312,639 as compared with \$299,611,995 in 1934 and \$268,972,936 in 1933. Purchases of securities from all countries during the same period were \$222,926,428 in comparison with \$280,585,753 in 1934 and \$214,826,681 in 1933. Sales to the United States for the same eleven months period increased each year, being \$238,049,317 in 1935, \$198,964,759 in 1934 and \$195,958,022 in 1933. Purchases from the United States during this period were \$176,411,551 in 1935, \$256,506,568 in 1934 and \$181,737,259 in 1933. Sales to Great Britain during the eleven months period were greatly reduced in 1935, having declined to \$24,789,136 as compared with \$97,700,939 in 1934 and \$71,019,899 in 1933. Purchases from Great Britain on the other hand have risen to \$40,967,848 during this period in 1935 from \$20,102,444 in 1934 and \$26,281,763 in 1933. It should be noted that the new public issue of \$76,000,000 Dominion Government bonds sold to a New York syndicate in August, 1935, and the \$20,000,000 short-term banking credit dated September 1 arranged in New York for the Dominion Government are not included in these figures.

Tables showing exchange quotations, the index numbers of common stock prices, and quotations and yields on representative bonds in Great Britain, the United States and Canada are included in this bulletin. They show during November that while the premium on sterling funds remained about the same as October there was a slight decline in the premium on New York funds. The only yield that increased during the month was that on Dominion of Canada 3's June, 1, 1950-55 which on November 13 was 3.13 per cent ("and interest" basis). The yield on United States 3% Treasury Bonds of 1951-55 ("and interest" basis) remained at 2.80 per cent in November while the yield on Great Britain War Loan 31% Callable December 1, 1952 ("flat" price basis) declined to 3.11 per cent and that on Dominion of Canada 42% Conversion Loan 1948-58 ("and interest" basis) declined to 3.74 per cent.




