SALES AND PURCHASES OF SECURITIES BETWEEN CANADA AND OTHER COUNTRIES

### June, 1944.

Net sales of securities by Canada to other countries were \$10.2 million in June compared with \$18.7 million in May and \$6.6 million in April. The general character of this inflow of capital was the same as formerly with sales of Canadian bonds remaining the dominant element.

There were net sales of each group of Canadian bonds in the trade with the United States. Some concentration occurred in the trade in Dominions, net sales of which constituted \$3.3 million out of the total net sales of Canadian bonds to the United States of \$8.4 million. While the volume of trading in Canadian stocks was greater than in any earlier month of the year, there was only a negligible balance of sales in these securities. The liquidation of Canadian holdings of United States stocks of \$1.4 million was comparable to the level of preceding months. There were also some sales of United States bonds.

Net repurchases from the United Kingdom of \$1.3 million were distributed between Canadian bonds and stocks.

Trading with other countries produced net sales of \$0.1 million.

In the first half of 1944 the balance of sales to all countries was \$59.9 million compared with \$99.0 million in the first half of 1943. Most of this decline occurred in the trade in Canadian bonds, net sales of which were \$51.5 million in this period of 1944 and \$79.5 million in 1943. Repurchases of Canadian stocks of \$1.0 million in 1944 compare with net sales of the same amount in the first half of 1943. Sales of United States securities, amounting to \$10.6 million in 1944, compare with \$16.2 million in 1943.

Considerable increases in common stock prices in Canada and the United States were recorded by each of the index numbers shown in Table 5, while the prices of the government bonds shown in Table 4 remained stable. The official buying and selling rates for foreign exchange remained at the levels fixed in September, 1939.

The international trade in securities shown by statistics in this bulletin was carried on through the medium of the investment dealers, stock exchanges, banks, Canadian branches of United States houses and other agencies in Canada. It should be noted that certain types of international security transactions are not included in these statistics. Besides some transactions carried on directly outside of Canada independently of the reporting agencies the most important group of security transactions not included are new issues of Canadian securities floated abroad, the redemption of called or matured Canadian bonds owned abroad, and official repatriation operations. For a period of years, retirements of Canadian bonds owned outside of Canada have exceeded flotations of new issues abroad by substantial amounts. Statistics of these capital movements are included in the annual reports of the Canadian Balance of International Payments.
