SALES AND PURCHASES OF SECURITIES BETWEEN CANADA AND OTHER COUNTRIES

August, 1944

Net sales of securities by Canada to other countries in August were \$8.4 million compared with \$9.7 million in July and \$10.2 million in June. This inflow of capital retained the same general outlines as in preceding months, sales of bonds being the main source.

Sales of bonds to the United States were distributed among each group of bonds; although sales of Dominion guarantees accounted for almost \$4.0 million of total net sales of Canadian bonds to the United States of \$7.9 million. There was some decline in the volume of trading in Canadian stocks with a small balance of repurchases compared with net sales in the three preceeding months. There was also a slight decline in the volume of trading in United States stocks with an accompanying reduction in the net sales.

Net repurchases of securities from the United Kingdom of \$0.9 million were as usual distributed between Canadian Stocks and bonds

There were net sales of \$0.2 million to other countries

In the first eight months of 1944 the balance of sales to all countries was \$77.9 million compared with \$134.3 million in the same months of 1943. Reduced sales of Canadian bonds account for most of the decline in capital inflow, net sales of these being \$66.7 million in the eight months of 1944 compared with \$110.5 million in the corresponding months of 1943. Repurchases of Canadian stocks of \$4.6 million in these months of 1944 compare with net sales of \$1.0 million in the eight months of 1943. Sales of United States securities of \$12.3 million in this period of 1944 compare with \$19.6 million in 1943.

Each of the index numbers of common stock prices in Canada and the United States shown in Table 5 declined in August from the highest points for the year reached in July, while the prices of government bonds shown in Table 4 remained relatively stable. The official buying and selling rates for foreign exchange remained at the levels fixed in September, 1939.

The international trade in securities shown by statistics in this bulletin was carried on through the medium of the investment dealers, stock exchanges, banks, Canadian branches of United States houses and other agencies in Canada. It should be noted that certain types of international security transactions are not included in these statistics. Besides some transactions carried on directly outside of Canada independently of the reporting agencies the most important group of security transactions not included are new issues of Canadian securities floated abroad, the redemption of called or matured Canadian bonds owned abroad, and official repatriation operations. For a period of years, retirements of Canadian bonds owned outside of Canada have exceeded flotations of new issues abroad by substantial amounts. Statistics of these capital movements are included in the annual reports of the Canadian Balance of International Payments.
