SALES AND PURCHASES OF SECURITIES BETWEEN CANADA AND OTHER COUNTRIES

September, 1944.

Net sales of securities by Canada to other countries in September were \$3.4 million compared with \$8.4 million in August and \$9.7 million in July. This represents a smaller inflow of capital than in any month since September 1943 and mainly reflects a contraction in sales of Canadian bonds to the United States.

While smaller in volume, the net sales of bonds to the United States of \$3.3 million continued to be distributed among each group of Canadian bonds with the exception of Dominion issues which were repurchased on balance. Canadian stocks were also repurchased from the United States. There were net sales of United States stocks of about \$1.6 million arising from a smaller volume of trading.

Net repurchases of securities from the United Kingdom of \$1.9 million were larger than usual and were distributed between Canadian stocks and bonds.

There were net sales of \$0.3 million to other countries.

In the first three quarters of 1944 the balance of sales to all countries was \$81.3 million compared with \$136.8 million in the same months of 1943. Reduced sales of Canadian bonds account for most of the decline in capital inflow, net sales of these being \$68.9 million in the nine months of 1944 compared with \$111.7 million in the same months of 1943. Ir this period of 1944 repurchases of Canadian stocks of \$5.3 million compare with net sales of Canadian stocks of \$1.2 million in the first three quarters of 1943. Sales of United States securities in this period were \$13.9 million in 1944 compared with \$20.8 million in 1943.

Each of the index numbers of common stock prices in Canada and the United States shown in Table 5 declined in September while the government bonds shown in Table 4 remained relatively stable. The official buying and selling rates for foreign exchange remained at the levels fixed in September, 1939.

The international trade in securities shown by statistics in this bulletin was carried on through the medium of the investment dealers, stock exchanges, banks. Canadian branches of United States houses and other agencies in Canada. It should be noted that certain types of international security transactions are not included in these statistics. Besides some transactions carried on directly outside of Canada independently of the reporting agencies the most important group of security transactions not included are new issues of Canadian securities floated abroad, the redemption of called or matured Canadian bonds owned abroad, and official repatriation operations. For a period of years, retirements of Canadian bonds owned outside of Canada have exceeded flotations of new issues abroad by substantial amounts. Statistics of these capital movements are included in the annual reports of the Canadian Balance of International Payments.
