SALES AND PURCHASES OF SECURITIES BETWEEN CANADA AND OTHER COUNTRIES

MAY, 1945

Total net sales of securities by Canada to other countries amounted to \$18.9 million in May compared with \$14.1 million in April and \$10.0 million in March. Sales of Canadian bonds represented a larger part of the import of capital in May than in the preceding months.

Net sales of securities to the United States of \$22.0 million in May were exceptionally high. Sales of Canadian bonds accounted for \$12.8 million and were distributed among each group of issues. Sales of Dominions at \$7.4 million were at a higher level than usual. Sales of provincials were \$1.9 million, other railway issues \$1.0 million, and the remaining sales were distributed among each of the other groups. Net sales of Canadian stocks to the United States were \$4.1 million, and net sales of United States stocks were \$3.1 million.

Net repurchases of securities from the United Kingdom increased to \$3.1 million, of which \$2.7 million was made up of Canadian stocks and the remainder divided between Canadian bonds and United Kingdom stocks.

The trade with other countries was small and practically in equilibrium.

In the first five months of 1945 net sales of securities amounted to \$64.0 million compared with \$49.6 million in the corresponding months of 1944. This increase results chiefly from increased sales of Canadian stocks of \$6.6 million in 1945, compared with repurchases of \$3.3 million in 1944, and from net sales of United States stocks of \$15.0 million in 1945, an increase of \$6.1 million over the same period of 1944.

The index numbers of common stocks prices in Canada and the United States all increased sharply to new high levels in May. The prices of Government bonds shown in Table 4 remained relatively stable. The official buying and selling rates for foreign exchange remained at the levels fixed in September, 1939.

The international trade in securities shown by statistics in this bulletin was carried on through the medium of the investment dealers, stock exchanges, banks, Canadian branches of United States houses and other agencies in Canada. It should be noted that certain types of international security transactions are not included in these statistics. Besides some transactions carried on directly outside of Canada independently of the reporting agencies the most important group of security transactions not included are new issues of Canadian securities floated abroad, the redemption of called or matured Canadian bonds owned abroad, and official repatriation operations. For a period of years, retirements of Canadian bonds owned outside of Canada have exceeded flotations of new issues abroad by substantial amounts. Statistics of these capital movements are included in the annual reports of the <u>Canadian</u> Balance of International Payments.
