SALES AND PURCHASES OF SECURITIES BETWEEN CANADA AND OTHER COUNTRIES

JULY, 1945

Total net sales of securities to all countries in July, while much lower than the record high level of \$35.1 million in June, were, at \$21.7 million, higher than any month since July 1943. The demand for Canadian bonds continued heavy but sales of Canadian and United States stocks were somewhat below recent levels.

Net sales of securities to the United States of \$23.9 million, were, with the exception of June, the highest since June 1943. Sales of Canadian bonds accounted for \$20.8 million, \$14.9 million of this being concentrated in Dominion issues. Net sales of Dominion Guarantees were \$1.8 million, provincials \$1.7 million and other corporations \$1.2 million. Net sales of Canadian stocks to the United States were \$1.0 million and net sales of United States stocks \$1.6 million.

Net repurchases of securities from the United Kingdom were \$2.6 million, \$2.0 million in Canadian stocks, the remaining \$0.6 million divided between the different issues of Canadian bonds. The trade in July was more comparable to earlier months of the year than in June when repurchases of stock were at a record level.

Trade with other countries increased moderately and represented net sales of \$0.4 million.

In the seven months ending July 1945, net sales of securities to all countries were \$120.8 million compared with \$65.5 million in the corresponding period of 1944. This increase arises from increased sales of Canadian stocks of \$5.2 million in 1945 compared with repurchases of \$4.1 million in 1944, an increase of \$11.2 million in net sales of United States stocks in 1945 and heavier net sales of Canadian bonds which were \$28.4 million larger in this period of 1945 than in the corresponding period of 1944.

The index number of common stocks prices in Canada and the United States all were somewhat lower than the high levels established in June. The prices of Government bonds shown in Table 4 showed only minor changes. The official buying and selling rates for foreign exchange remained at the levels fixed in September 1939.

The international trade in securities shown by statistics in this bulletin was carried on through the medium of the investment dealers, stock exchanges, banks, Canadian branches of United States houses and other agencies in Canada. It should be noted that certain types of international security transactions are not included in these statistics. Besides some transactions carried on directly outside of Canada independently of the reporting agencies the most important group of security transactions not included are new issues of Canadian securities floated abroad, the redemption of called or matured Canadian bonds owned abroad, and official repatriation operations. For a period of years, retirements of Canadian bonds owned outside of Canada have exceeded flotations of new issues abroad by substantial amounts. Statistics of these capital movements are included in the annual reports of the Canadian Balance of International Payments.
