SALES AND PURCHASES OF SECURITIES BETWEEN CANADA AND OTHER COUNTRIES February, 1947

In February, 1947, sales of securities by Canada to other countries were approximately equal to purchases, both figures totalling \$24.9 million. This compares with net sales of \$3.2 million in January and net sales of \$34.9 million in February, 1946. Net repurchases of Canadian common and preferred stocks (\$1.8 million), of Dominion, Provincial and Dominion-guaranteed bonds (\$1.3, \$0.5 and \$1.1 million respectively) were largely offset by sales of new Canadian bond issues (\$1.0 million) and net sales of other Canadian corporation bonds (\$3.2 million).

Net sales of securities to the United States amounted to \$0.9 million, with net Canadian bond sales of \$1.5 million. Net sales of "other corporation" bonds were \$3.1 million, but Dominion and Dominion-guaranteed bonds were, on balance, repurchased from the U.S.A. to the extent of \$1.1 million and \$1.2 million respectively. Net repurchases of Canadian common and preferred stocks from the U.S.A. were \$1.0 million, against net sales of U.S. stocks amounting to \$0.1 million.

Net repurchases of securities from the U.K. were \$1.0 million, composed of \$0.7 million Canadian common and preferred stocks and \$0.3 million Canadian bonds.

Net sales of Canadian bonds accounted for a net sales figure of \$0.1 million to other countries, all other securities showing small purchase balances.

During the first two months of 1947, net sales to all countries amounted to \$3.2 million, compared with \$52.6 million for the same period of 1946. The decrease was principally due to a reduction in net sales of Dominion bonds (from \$39.3 million to \$3.3 million). Net repurchases of Canadian common and preferred stocks during the two-month period increased from \$0.1 million in 1946 to \$7.9 million in 1947, and net sales of U.S. stocks amounting to \$5.9 million in January-February 1946 were replaced by net purchases of \$0.4 million during the same period of 1947.

In Table 4, showing quotations and yields for domestic government bonds in Canada, the United Kingdom and the U.S.A., the Canadian and U.S. issues show small price increases and the British issue a slight decrease.

In Table 5, showing index numbers of common stocks prices in Canada and the U.S.A., all groups show price increases, ranging from 1.6 for Canadian golds to 3.5 for U.S. industrials and utilities.

The international trade in securities shown by statistics in this bulletin was carried on through the medium of the investment dealers, stock exchanges, banks, Canadian branches of United States houses and other agencies in Canada. It should be noted that certain types of international security transactions are not included in these statistics. Besides some transactions carried on directly outside of Canada independently of the reporting agencies, the most important group of security transactions not included are new issues of Canadian securities floated abroad, the redemption of called or matured Canadian bonds owned abroad, and official repatriation operations. For a period of years, retirements of Canadian bonds owned outside of Canada have exceeded flotations of new issues abroad by substantial amounts. Statistics of these capital movements are included in the annual reports of the Canadian Balance of International Payments.
