SALES AND PURCHASES OF SECURITIES BETWEEN CANADA AND OTHER COUNTRIES August, 1947

The volume of trade in securities between Canada and all other countries during August registered a minor increase over July. Total sales dropped by \$0.6 million to \$10.9 million (the lowest monthly figure since September, 1943), while purchases were \$2.0 million higher at \$13.2 million.

In trade with the U.S.A., net purchases of \$1.4 million more than offset the sales balance of July, on account of an abrupt increase of \$2.5 million in total purchases while total sales remained almost the same. Dominion bonds were the major factor in both totals: sales of these bonds were \$3.1 million (up \$1.8 million from July) and purchases \$4.4 million (up \$3.3 million). Sales of Canadian stocks dropped \$0.7 million and of U.S. stocks \$0.6 million, but purchases of both these types of securities remained close to the July level.

Trade with the United Kingdom was little more than half that of the previous month, sales and purchases each falling by about half a million dollars to produce a purchase balance of \$1.1 million, the same as in July.

Gross trade with other countries was about the same as in July, with a small total of transactions resulting in net sales of \$0.1 million.

The eight months ending August, 1947 provided a total purchase balance of \$9.5 million, as against net sales of \$131.0 million during the period January to August, 1946. (It may be noted here that August, 1946 was the last of an unbroken series of months showing sales balances, which commenced in October, 1939.) Total bond sales exceeded purchases by \$17.1 million, with Canadian corporation bonds (net sales \$11.5 million) the weightiest factor. Net repurchases of Canadian stocks totalled \$16.0 million, and net purchases of U.S. stocks \$1.7 million.

Table 4 shows a small decline in the quotation for a typical Dominion bond during August, while U.S. bonds advanced slightly and U.K. bonds fell over 3 points.

The composite index of 100 Canadian common stocks, shown in Table 5, receded almost 2 points in August, and the U.S. common stocks index 1.5 points. A rise of 1.7 points in golds was a major factor in advancing the index for Canadian mines as a whole by 1.2 points to the highest level since February.

Statistics in this bulletin cover transactions reported by investment firms, stock exchanges and other security dealers in Canada. Not included are: new issues of Canadian securities floated abroad, redemptions of called or matured Canadian bonds owned abroad, and some transactions by other than the reporting agencies. Complete statistics regarding capital movements are included in the annual reports on the Canadian Balance of International Payments.
