SALES AND PURCHASES OF SECURITIES BETWEEN CANADA AND OTHER COUNTRIES

MARCH, 1948

In March 1948 sales of securities by residents of Canada to buyers in other countries, were approximately equal to purchases from other countries, the transactions in each case aggregating \$15.6 million. Sales increased by \$2.6 million from the previous month and purchases increased by \$0.1 million.

Transactions with the United States resulted in a sales balance for the first time since October 1947. The balance was not large, amounting to \$0.6 million, and was due principally to sales of new Canadian bond issues floated in Canada. Transactions in outstanding bond issues and in common and preferred stocks resulted in a small purchase balance of \$0.4 million.

The volume of trade with the United Kingdom in March was the largest in any month since September 1947. The purchase balance of \$0.5 million was principally due to repurchases of Canadian provincials and municipals and Canadian stocks.

In transactions with other countries, sales and purchases each amounted to \$0.2 million.

During the first quarter of 1948 net purchases from all countries totalled \$5.1 million, representing a continuation of the general trend of 1947 which resulted in a purchase balance of \$18.0 million in the year's transactions. Repurchases of Dominion bonds and Canadian stocks were the most prominent features during the first quarter.

In Table 4 showing quotations and yields for representative government bonds in Canada, the United Kingdom and the United States, the price of the Canadian issue continued the decline which commenced in September 1947, while the United Kingdom and United States issues recorded minor advances.

Prices of Canadian stocks continued to drop in March, but at a slower rate than in February, while United States stocks made the first recovery since October 1947.

Statistics in this bulletin cover transactions reported by investment firms, stock exchanges and other security dealers in Canada. Not included are: new issues of Canadian securities floated abroad, redemptions of called or matured Canadian bonds owned abroad, and some transactions by other than the reporting agencies. Complete statistics regarding capital movements are included in the annual reports on the Canadian Balance of International Payments.
