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
Sales and Purchases of Securities Between Canada and Other Countries

February, 1936

In February the international trade in securities between Canada and other countries remained heavy although there was some decline from the exceptional volume recorded in January. This reduction in trade during the month was in the sales to the United States and to Great Britain, the quantity of purchases remaining about the same as in January. Despite the decline in sales in February, a large net balance of sales continued to characterize the month's transactions. A net balance of sales was present in both the trade with the United States and with Great Britain. The decline in the international trade in securities during the month was in stocks as well as in bonds. This trade in securities between Canada and other countries was carried on through the medium of the investment dealers, stock exchanges, banks, United States branch houses, and other agencies.

In February, 1936, sales to the United States were \$36,260,759 compared with \$45,260,642 in January, and purchases from the United States were \$28,329,794 compared with \$28,974,654 in January. Sales to Great Britain were \$5,993,537 in February and \$11,112,761 in January, while purchases from Great Britain were \$3,540,208 and \$3,092,797 in these respective months. Total sales to all countries in the first two months of 1936 were \$99,048,481 as compared with \$36,910,780 in the same months of 1935 and \$60,483,326 in 1934. Total purchases from all other countries in the first two months of each year were \$64,596,819 in 1936, \$\phi41,047,233\$ in 1935, and \$55,144,120 in 1934. It should be noted that sales of new issues of Canadian securities outside of Canada are not included in these figures, such as the new issue of Dominion of Canada bonds of \$48,000,000 sold in January, 1936, in New York to a syndicate headed by the First Boston Corporation.

Tables showing exchange quotations, the index numbers of common stock prices, and quotations and yields on representative government bonds in Great Britain, the United States and Canada are included in this bulletin. The monthly average of quotations for New York funds in Montreal showed a discount in February for the first time since January, 1935, while the premium on sterling at Montreal increased slightly. The index of common stock prices in Canada increased sharply from 112.9 in January to 120.7 in February. The indices of common stock prices in Great Britain and the United States also increased. The yield on each of the government securities shown declined except in the case of the Dominion of Canada 3's June 1, 1950-55. The yield for this security increased from 3.14 per cent in January to 3.16 per cent in February.






