Sales and Purchases of Securities Between Canada and Other Countries.

#### February, 1938.

In Canada's international trade in securities in February, total sales exceeded total purchases for the fourth consecutive month. Net sales to all countries during February were more than \$4 1/2 million, compared with net sales of \$4 million in January, although the volume of the trade was considerably reduced.

In the trade with the United States, the net inflow of capital noted in the three preceding months, continued in diminished volume. The net inflow in February amounted to over \$3 million, compared with \$5 million in January. Transactions in bonds and debentures between Canada and the United States decreased considerably. Purchases of these securities from the United States exceeded sales by \$0.6 million. Net sales of Dominion government bonds were balanced by purchases of Canadian Provincial, Municipal, Railway and Corporation issues and United States Corporation bonds. Net purchases of unspecified issues exceeded \$1/2 million. Total net sales to the United States were concentrated in Canadian securities although Canada sold on balance over \$1 million United States common and preference stocks, the selling principally reflecting the continued United States demand for Canadian stocks. In connection with the decline in the volume of transactions between Canada and the United States in recent months, it is interesting to note that the decline in transactions in United States securities has been much greater than the decline in Canadian securities.

The volume of securit, transactions between Canada and the United Kingdom declined by over 25% or \$3.8 million, the decline being principally in purchases from the United Kingdom with the result that net purchases of \$2 million in January were converted into a small net sale.

Canada continued to sell on balance Canadian stocks and bonds to countries other than the United Kingdom and the United States. Net sales remained at about \$1 million. The net transactions represented, for the most part, purchases of Canadian stocks by "Other Countries".


In the first two months of 1938, the net movement of capital from the United States to Canada through the purchase and sale of securities was over 58.7 million, compared with a net movement in the opposite direction of \$8.2 million in the similar period of 1937. During the first two months of 1938 security transactions accounted for a net movement of \$2 million from Canada to the United Kingdom, contrasted with an inflow from the United Kingdom of over \$11.3 million during January and February, 1937. Total volume of transactions declined in the first two months of the year from \$249.6 million in 1937 and \$106.6 million in 1938.

The following changes are indicated in tables 4, 5 and 6: United States funds at Montreal declined to slightly below par, while the premium on sterling at Montreal increased to 3.08 per cent. The prices of all of the government bonds shown were firmer. The index number of common stocks in England declined 6 points, while the Canadian and United States index numbers declined only 0.6 and 0.9 points respectively.

The International security transactions shown in this bulletin were carried on through the medium of the investment dealers, stock exchanges, banks, United States branch houses and other agencies in Canada. The sale of new issues of Canadian securities to syndicate members resident outside of Canada are not included in these figures, such as the new issues of \$85,000,000 Dominion of Canada bonds sold in January, 1937, to a syndicate in New York, the \$3,250,000 Province of New Brunswick bonds sold privately in the United States in August and the £10,000,000 Dominion loan underwritten in London in January 1933. The redemption of called or matured Canadian securities abroad and of British and foreign securities cwned in Canada are not included among the transactions recorded.
