The value of Canada's international security trade during August showed a decline of almost 19 per cent below the volume recorded in July. Sales to all countries declined about 20 per cent or \$7.4 million; purchases from all countries declined about 18 per cent or \$5.4 million. Net sales, as a result, were \$2 million lower at \$4.7 million. The greater part of the decline in trade took place in sales and purchases of United States common and preference stocks, in which trading had reached unusually large proportions in the previous month. Sales and purchases of Canadian securities represented over 66 per cent, and United States securities over 30 per cent of total transactions. During August, Canada sold on balance to the United States securities in excess of \$5.2 million, compared with net sales in July of about \$4.6 million. Net sales to the United States during the month were recorded in Canadian Provincial, Municipal, issues guaranteed by the Dominion, Railway and Corporation bonds and Canadian and United States common and preference stocks while there were not repurchases of about 31 million Dominion

The valume of security transactions between Canada and the United Kingdom in August declined over 24 per cent from the total for July, sales to the United Kingdom being almost \$3.5 million lower and purchases from the United Kingdom about \$0.6 million higher with resulting net purchases of over \$3.5 million. Canada purchased on balance from the United Kingdom during the month, Dominion government, Provincial and Municipal bonds, issues guaranteed by the Dominion government, United Kingdom non-government issues and Canadian stocks.


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Canada's total security trade with countries other than the United States and the United Kingdom receded slightly during August, due to the sharp reduction in Canadian purchases, but sales to "Other Countries" reached the highest total reported for any month in which these transactions have been recorded. The exceptionally large net sales of \$3 million were represented by sales on balance of \$1 million in Canadian bonds and \$2 million in Canadian common and preference stocks.

In the supplementary tables, the following changes are recorded in August. The premium on both New York and Sterling funds at Montreal declined, the latter continuing the sharp decline appearing in July. The bid price of the United States 3 per cent government bond shown in Table 5 advanced slightly; the price of the 4-1/2 per cent Dominion of Canada government bond showed no change from the July level; the bid prices of the 3 per cent Dominion of Canada and the 3-1/2 per cent United Kingdom bonds registered moderate declines. The index numbers of Canadian mining stocks and United States common stocks prices advanced, while the English and Canadian Investors' indexes recorded small losses.

During the first eight months of 1938, the volume of Canada's international trade in securities was almost \$440 million, as compared with over \$731 million for the similar period of 1937. However, the net inward movement of capital was greater in 1938, net sales to all countries to the end of August, 1938, exceeding \$26.6 million, compared with slightly over \$8 million in the same months of 1937. Sales on balance to the United States for the first eight months of 1938 were more than \$25.5 million: during the same period Canada purchased on balance from the United Kingdom securities to the extent of almost \$9.3 million, and sold on balance to "Other Countries" more than \$10 million in securities.

During the eight-month period, Canada sold on balance over \$10.6 million of Canadian bonds and almost \$17.5 million of Canadian stocks to the United States, over \$1.6 million in Canadian bonds to the United Kingdom and \$2.1 million in Canadian bonds and \$8.8 million in Canadian stocks to "Other Countries"; during the same period repurchases of Canadian stocks from the United Kingdom exceeded \$9.1 million.




The international security transactions shown in this bulletin were carried on through the medium of the investment dealers, stock exchanges, banks, United States branch houses and other agencies in Canada. The sale of new issues of Canadian securities to syndicate members resident outside of Canada are not included in these figures, such as the new issues of \$85,000,000 Dominion of Canada bonds sold in January, 1937, to a syndicate in New York, the \$3,250,000 Province of New Brunswick bonds sold privately in the United States in August and the £10,000,000 Dominion loan underwritten in London in January, 1938. The redemption of called or matured Canadian securities abroad and of British and foreign securities owned in Canada are not included among the transactions recorded.
