Sales and Purchases of Securities Between Canada and Other Countries

September, 1938.

Little change is shown in the volume or direction of Canada's international security trade during September, in spite of unsettled conditions in security markets and foreign exchanges. Sales to all countries were more than \$1 million higher and purchases from all countries over \$1 1/2 million lower than in the preceding month. As a result, September net sales were nearly \$7.7 million compared with net sales of over \$4.7 million in August. During the month, Canada sold on balance to all countries about \$4.4 million of Canadian stocks, and \$3.3 million of United States stocks. Sales and purchases of Canadian securities represented nearly 64% and United States securities nearly 33% of total transactions.


During September, Canada sold on balance to the United States, securities in excess of \$5.4 million, compared with net sales of about \$5.2 million in August and \$4.6 million in July. Net sales to the United States were recorded in Canadian Municipal bonds, issues guaranteed by the Dominion, Corporation bonds, outstanding issues of "Other Countries", and in Canadian and United States stocks; net purchases from the United States were recorded in Dominion and Provincial government bonds, unguaranteed Railway issues and United States corporation issues.

For the second successive month, volume of security transactions between Canada and the United Kingdom showed a decline. Sales of securities to the United Kingdom increased nearly \$1 million over the previous month, whereas purchases of securities from the United Kingdom declined by more than \$3 million. Net sales were about \$1/2 million in September compared with net purchases from the United Kingdom in August of over \$3.5 million. Canada sold the United Kingdom on balance nearly \$0.7 million of Canadian stocks during the current month, compared with net repurchases in August of nearly \$1.4 million.

The volume of Canada's security trade with countries other than the United States and the United Kingdom showed a decline from the volume in August. Sales to "Other Countries" declined from the unusually large total recorded in the previous month, but, nevertheless, net sales were about \$1.7 million, practically all of which represented sales on balance of Canadian common and preference stocks.

In the supplementary tables, the following changes are recorded in September. The premium on New York funds at Montreal, as shown by the average of daily quotations during the month, increased slightly: for the first time in three years, the average of daily quotations for sterling funds at Montreal was at a discount. Exchange fluctuations were much wider than those indicated by these averages, however. The bid price of the United Kingdom, United States and Dominion of Canada government bonds shown, recorded declines, the first mentioned declining sharply. Fluctuations in these prices also were wider than are indicated by the mid-month quotations. The index numbers of Common stocks prices in Canada, England and United States also recorded sharp drops in prices.

During the first nine months of 1938, the volume of Canada's international trade in securities exceeded \$494 million, as compared with more than \$803 million in the similar period of 1937 and over \$511 million to end of September, 1936. The net inflow of capital resulting from security transactions for the first nine months of 1938 exceeded \$34 million compared with an inflow of over \$12 million for nine months of 1936 and an outflow of over \$5 million for the similar period of 1937. Sales on balance to the United States to end of September, 1938, were nearly \$31 million: purchases on balance from the United Kingdom to end of September were nearly \$9 million: during the similar period, net sales to countries other than the United States and the United Kingdom were more than \$12 million.




During the mine-month period, Canada sold on balance more than \$14.1 million of Canadian bonds and \$21.6 million of Canadian stocks to all countries; net sales to the United States during this period were about \$11.4 million of Canadian bonds and debentures and more than \$19.5 million of Canadian stocks, net sales of Canadian bonds to the United Kingdom were nearly \$1.4 million and net sales to "Other Countries", more than \$2.1 million of Canadian bonds and nearly \$10.5 million of Canadian stocks; during the same period Canadian repurchases of Canadian stocks from the United Kingdom exceeded \$8.4 million.

The international security transactions shown in this bulletin were carried on through the medium of the investment dealers, stock exchanges, banks, United States branch houses and other agencies in Canada. The sale of new issues of Canadian securities to syndicate members resident outside of Canada are not included in these figures, such as the new issues of \$85,000,000 Dominion of Canada bonds sold in January, 1937, to a syndicate in New York, the \$3,250,000 Province of New Pronswick bonds sold privately in the United States in August and the £10,000,000 Dominion loan underwritten in London in January, 1938. The redemption of called or matured Canadian securities abroad and of British and foreign securities owned in Canada are not included among the transactions recorded.
