Sales and Purchases of Securities Between Canada and Other Countries

April, 1939.

A net inflow of capital to Canada accompanied international trading in securities in April, as in the first three months of the year. The amount of the influx was considerably reduced, however, and, in contrast to previous months, was almost all reported as coming from countries other than the United Kingdom and the United States, as sales of securities to the United States were sharply reduced. Total sales by Canada to all countries were about \$26.7 million compared with sales of almost \$43 million in March and \$20.5 million in April, 1938. Purchases of securities from all other countries during April declined to \$21.6 million from more than \$26.4 million in March. Accordingly net sales of about \$5.1 million were lower than net sales in each month of the first quarter.


As a result of the decline in sales to the United States net sales to that country in April were reduced to less than \$1/2 million. The decline was distributed among most groups of securities. Consequently, nearly \$1.3 million of Canadian stocks were repurchased on balance. Net sales to the United States of American common and preference stocks were reduced to about \$1.2 million. Net sales to the United States of Canadian bonds declined approximately \$3/4 million, while there were net purchases of American bonds of about \$1/4 million.

A small balance of sales by Canada was recorded in the security trade with the United Kingdom. Repurchases of nearly \$0.7 million of Canadian bonds and debentures were more than offset by sales to the United Kingdom of more than \$0.9 million of Canadian stocks. The bulk of the transactions with the United Kingdom were in Canadian securities.

The net inflow of capital from transactions executed directly with countries other than the United Kingdom and the United States, more than \$4.3 million, was greater than in any previous month during the six years in which the trade has been recorded. Sales on balance to "Other Countries" of Canadian stocks were more than \$3.3 million; net sales of Canadian bonds were almost \$0.9 million.

During the first four months of 1939, the volume of Canada's international trade in securities exceeded \$232 million, an amount about \$11 million higher than the total for the similar period of 1938. The net inward movement of capital in 1939 was much heavier than in 1938, however. Sales on balance to all countries to end of April, 1939 were about \$50 million as compared with net sales of about \$4 million to end of April, 1938. For the first four months of the year, net sales of Canadian stocks were more than \$12 million in 1939, compared with about \$8 million in 1938; net sales of Canadian bonds were about \$24.5 million in 1939 compared with net purchases of about \$0.6 million in 1938; and net sales of United States securities were \$12.5 million compared with \$1.3 million in 1938. On balance Canada sold Dominion, Provincial and Municipal government bonds, issues guaranteed by the Dominion, Canadian corporation bonds and stocks, United States stocks and government bonds and United Kingdom stocks and government and corporation bonds, and stocks of "Other Countries"; net purchases were recorded in the four-month period in unguaranteed Canadian Railway bonds, United States corporation bonds, and bonds of "Other Countries."

Of the balance of sales to all countries of more than \$50 million, more than \$35 million or 70% represented net sales to the United States; slightly more than \$3 million or 6% represented net sales to the United Kingdom, and the remainder of the balance, almost \$12 million or 24%, is accounted for by net sales to other countries.




In the supplementary tables, the following changes are recorded in April: The premium on New York funds at Montreal, as shown by the average of daily quotations during the month rose slightly to 0.50%; the discount on sterling funds increased slightly to 3.35%. The bid price of the United Kingdom, United States and Canadian government bonds shown, recorded declines, the decline recorded by the United Kingdom bond being the greatest. The index numbers of Canadian, English and American stocks prices declined quite sharply, in each case to the lowest point this year.

The international security transactions shown in this bulletin were carried on through the medium of the investment dealers, stocks exchanges, banks, United States branch houses and other agencies in Canada. The sale of new issues of Canadian securities to syndicate members resident outside of Canada is not included in these figures, such as, for example, the new issues of \$40,000,000 Dominion of Canada bonds sold in November, 1938 to a syndicate in New York; £10,000,000 Dominion loan underwritten in London in January, 1938; \$4,000,000 City of Montreal bonds sold in February to a syndicate in the Netherlands; and \$20,000,000 Dominion of Canada notes sold to banks in New York, February, 1939. The redemption of called or matured Canadian securities abroad and of British and foreign securities owned in Canada are not included among the transactions recorded.
