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

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
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COMMENTARY**Overview**

In October, employment continued to grow moderately (+19,000), bringing gains since July to 72,000. This third consecutive employment gain follows an eight month pause in employment growth. The unemployment rate rose by 0.2 percentage points in October to 9.4 %, the combined result of an increase in overall labour force participation and an employment loss among men aged 25 and over. This increase in the unemployment rate follows a decline of 0.4 percentage points in September.

COMMENTAIRE**Aperçu**

En octobre, l'emploi a continué d'augmenter modérément (+19 000), portant les gains à 72 000 depuis juillet. Ce troisième gain consécutif fait suite à une pause de huit mois dans la croissance de l'emploi. Le taux de chômage a augmenté de 0,2 point de pourcentage en octobre, pour se fixer à 9,4 %, ce qui est le résultat d'une augmentation dans l'ensemble de l'activité combinée à des pertes d'emplois chez les hommes âgés de 25 ans et plus. L'augmentation du taux de chômage fait suite à un déclin de 0,4 point de pourcentage en septembre.

**Employment trend among adults is up despite job losses among men in October**

In October, a gain in full-time employment among adult women (+23,000) offset a decline in part-time employment (-20,000). Despite little change in overall employment for adult women in October, gains over the previous three months total 37,000 and this increase has been in full-time employment.

Tendance à la hausse de l'emploi chez les adultes, en dépit des pertes d'emplois enregistrées chez les hommes en octobre

En octobre, l'augmentation du nombre d'emplois à temps plein chez les femmes adultes (+23 000) a compensé pour un déclin du nombre d'emplois à temps partiel (- 20 000). Malgré le peu de changement enregistré dans l'ensemble de l'emploi chez les femmes adultes en octobre, les gains au cours des trois mois précédents ont totalisé 37 000 et étaient concentrés dans l'emploi à temps plein.

For adult men aged 25 and over, employment losses of 25,000 in October partly offset job gains of 65,000 observed during the previous three months. In October, the unemployment rate among adult men rose by seven-tenths of a percentage point to 8.4%, the result of both employment declines and labour force growth.

Despite this month's decline, adult men have made gains in full-time employment since July.

Youth employment volatile


In October, youths continued to experience volatile labour market conditions with a gain of 41,000 jobs offsetting a decline of 36,000 in September. Largely offsetting monthly fluctuations have left youth employment virtually unchanged from its year-end 1994 level. The proportion of the youth population with a job has also remained unchanged at 52.6%.

Les hommes âgés de 25 ans et plus ont enregistré des pertes d'emplois de 25 000 en octobre qui ont partiellement annulé les gains de 65 000 emplois observés au cours des trois mois précédents. En octobre, le taux de chômage chez les hommes adultes s'est accru de sept-dixièmes de point de pourcentage, pour se fixer à 8,4 %, et est le résultat à la fois du déclin de l'emploi et de la croissance de l'activité.

En dépit du déclin enregistré en octobre, les hommes adultes ont gagné des emplois à temps plein depuis juillet.


Versatilité de l'emploi chez les jeunes

En octobre, la situation des jeunes sur le marché du travail continue d'être instable avec un gain de 41 000 emplois qui compense un déclin de 36 000 emplois en septembre. Les fluctuations mensuelles à la hausse et à la baisse ont contribué à maintenir l'emploi chez les jeunes à peu près au même niveau qu'à la fin de 1994. La proportion de jeunes ayant un emploi est aussi restée la même à 52,6 %.



October's employment gain among youths pushed their unemployment rate down eight-tenths of a percentage point to 15.6%, the same as at the end of last year.

Les gains réalisés par les jeunes en octobre ont fait diminuer leur taux de chômage de huit-dixièmes de point de pourcentage pour le porter à 15,6 %, le même niveau qu'à la fin de 1994.



Growth in hours worked resumes

Following a drop of 0.5% during the first eight months of the year, hours worked have grown by 1.6% over the last two months. This resumes growth in hours worked which increased by 3.7% in 1994.

Industry trends

In October, employment grew by 37,000 in community, business and personal services, bringing gains since the beginning of the year to 70,000 (+1.4%).

While manufacturing employment was little changed in October, there has been a gain of 42,000 (+2.1%) jobs since the beginning of the year, with slightly stronger growth in hours worked (+2.5%). Last year, hours worked in manufacturing increased by 7.2% and employment rose by 6.7%.

Construction employment continued to show weakness with a slight decline in October (-9,000). Employment in this industry is down 58,000 (-7.6%) below the level attained in the spring of 1994.

Following strong growth in transportation, communication and other utilities during 1994 and in the first half of 1995, employment in this industry has dipped 27,000 below its June 1995 level.

La croissance dans les heures travaillées redémarre

Après une baisse de 0,5 % lors des huit premiers mois de l'année, les heures travaillées ont augmenté de 1,6 % au cours des deux derniers mois. Ceci fait redémarrer la croissance des heures travaillées, laquelle a augmenté de 3,7 % en 1994.

Tendances selon la branche d'activité

En octobre, l'emploi a augmenté de 37 000 dans les services socio-culturels, commerciaux et personnels. Cela porte à 70 000 (+1,4 %) les gains d'emploi dans cette branche d'activité depuis le début de l'année.

Même si l'emploi dans les industries manufacturières n'a pas subi beaucoup de changement en octobre, il a connu un gain de 42 000 (+2,1 %) emplois depuis le début de l'année avec une croissance légèrement plus forte dans les heures travaillées (+2,5 %). L'an passé, les heures travaillées dans les industries manufacturières ont augmenté de 7,2 % et l'emploi, de 6,7 %.

L'emploi dans la construction continue à éprouver des difficultés avec une légère diminution (- 9 000) en octobre. L'emploi dans cette branche d'activité est inférieur de 58 000 du niveau atteint au printemps de 1994.

Après une forte croissance dans les transports, communications et autres services publics au cours de 1994 et de la première moitié de 1995, l'emploi dans cette branche d'activité est tombé à 27 000 sous le niveau de juin 1995.

Employment in public administration has shown little change since July following declines observed earlier in the year.

Provincial labour markets

In October, there were employment gains in Québec (+17,000), Ontario (+18,000), Alberta (+7,000) and Prince Edward Island (+2,000). There was no significant change in employment in the other provinces.

Three-quarters of the 72,000 growth in overall employment observed since July reflects recent improvements in the labour markets of Québec and Ontario. Over the last three months, employment grew by 33,000 in Québec, ending an eight month streak of little change. Ontario gained 23,000 jobs since July, recovering two-thirds of the losses from the previous eight months.

L'emploi dans l'administration publique a montré peu de changement depuis juillet suite aux déclins observés plus tôt dans l'année.

Marchés du travail provinciaux

En octobre, l'emploi a augmenté au Québec (+17 000), en Ontario (+18 000), en Alberta (+7 000) et à l'Île-du-Prince-Édouard (+2 000). Aucun changement significatif de l'emploi n'a été enregistré dans les autres provinces.

Les trois quarts de la croissance globale de 72 000 emplois observée depuis juillet résultent de récentes améliorations dans les marchés du travail du Québec et de l'Ontario. Un accroissement de 33 000 emplois depuis les trois derniers mois au Québec a mis fin à une pause de huit mois. L'Ontario a gagné 23 000 emplois depuis juillet et a ainsi récupéré les deux-tiers des pertes subies au cours des huit mois précédents.

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


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Note de reconnaissance



Emploi désaisonnalisé selon certaines branches d'activités, Canada









