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
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COMMENTARY**Overview**

Employment dropped by 47,000 in September after an increase of 82,000 the previous month, leaving this year's total employment gains at 106,000. The decline in employment this month, combined with an increase in the number of people in the labour force, drove the unemployment rate up 0.5 of a percentage point to 9.9%.

COMMENTAIRE**Aperçu**


En septembre, l'emploi a baissé de 47 000 après avoir enregistré une hausse de 82 000 le mois précédent, ramenant les gains d'emploi observés depuis le début de l'année à 106 000. La baisse de l'emploi en septembre, combinée à une augmentation du nombre de personnes sur le marché du travail, a entraîné une hausse du taux de chômage de 0,5 point de pourcentage, le fixant à 9,9 %.

**Lower employment in the service-producing industries**

All of the employment losses in September were in the service-producing industries, down 48,000. A drop of 70,000 jobs in community, business and personal services wiped out all of the employment gains so far this year in this industry. Employment increased by 20,000 in finance, insurance and real estate, offsetting losses since May.

Régression de l'emploi dans le secteur des services


Le secteur des services a subi l'ensemble des pertes d'emploi en septembre, alors que l'emploi y a chuté de 48 000. Une chute de 70 000 emplois dans les services socio-culturels, commerciaux et personnels a annulé tous les gains réalisés dans cette branche d'activité depuis le début de l'année. Par contre, les finances, assurances et affaires immobilières ont affiché un accroissement de 20 000, lequel a permis à cette branche d'activité de récupérer les emplois perdus depuis mai dernier.

Upward trend in manufacturing employment

Though virtually unchanged in September, employment in the goods-producing industries is up by 94,000 since the beginning of the year. Manufacturing led the way during this period, with employment gains of 104,000. Most of this increase has taken place over the past six months, during which employment increased by 5.3% and hours worked rose by 4.3%. Growth in employment and hours worked are consistent with a marked increase in manufacturing shipments and lower inventories.

Tendance à la hausse de l'emploi dans les industries manufacturières

Bien que l'emploi dans le secteur de la production de biens n'a pratiquement pas varié en septembre, il se trouve en hausse de 94 000 comparativement au début de l'année. Ce sont les industries manufacturières qui ont mené le bal au cours de cette période alors que l'emploi y a augmenté de 104 000. Les industries manufacturières ont surtout progressé au cours des six derniers mois, alors que l'emploi a augmenté de 5,3 % et les heures travaillées, de 4,3 %. La croissance de l'emploi et des heures travaillées coïncidait avec une hausse marquée des livraisons totales des industries manufacturières et une baisse dans les inventaires.



Employment down in Ontario and New Brunswick

In September, employment dropped by 9,000 in New Brunswick after some minor fluctuations since the beginning of the year. Employment in Newfoundland, Prince Edward Island and Nova Scotia was unchanged in September. So far this year, Newfoundland and Nova Scotia have lost 4,000 and 11,000 jobs respectively, while employment in Prince Edward Island has not changed.

In Québec, employment showed little change in September. A gain in August partly offset losses earlier in the year leaving employment down 26,000 since December 1995.

Three quarters of September's overall employment decline occurred in Ontario. Employment in the province shrank by 35,000, partly offsetting the gain of 82,000 in the two previous months. The decrease occurred in service-producing industries, primarily community, business and personal services. So far this year, employment has grown by 67,000 in Ontario.

In Manitoba, employment rose by 5,000 in September, bringing this year's employment gains to 8,000. Employment in Saskatchewan was unchanged in September and remains at about the same level as in December 1995. In Alberta and British Columbia, employment showed no significant change in September, leaving gains at 33,000 and 30,000 respectively since the beginning of the year.

Employment down for both adults and youths

The employment decline of 47,000 in September affected both adults and youths. In the 25-and-over age group, a decrease of 28,000 jobs followed a large gain of 70,000 the previous month. Adult employment has grown by 127,000 since the beginning of the year.

Employment for 15 to 24 year olds fell by 19,000 in September, bringing youth employment losses since December 1995 to 21,000.

Baisse de l'emploi en Ontario et au Nouveau-Brunswick

En septembre, l'emploi a chuté de 9 000 au Nouveau-Brunswick, après avoir légèrement fluctué depuis le début de l'année. À Terre-Neuve, l'Île-du-Prince-Édouard et la Nouvelle-Écosse, l'emploi n'a pas varié en septembre. Par rapport au début de l'année, Terre-Neuve compte 4 000 emplois de moins, la Nouvelle-Écosse a perdu 11 000 emplois alors que l'Île-du-Prince-Édouard n'affiche aucun changement.

Au Québec, l'emploi a peu varié en septembre. Un gain en août a partiellement compensé les pertes survenues plus tôt au cours de l'année, laissant l'emploi en baisse de 26 000 depuis décembre 1995.

En septembre, les trois quarts de la diminution globale de l'emploi s'est produite en Ontario, alors que l'emploi y a décliné de 35 000, annulant partiellement le gain de 82 000 survenu lors des deux mois précédents. La baisse s'est manifestée dans le secteur des services, principalement dans les services socio-culturels, commerciaux et personnels. Jusqu'à présent cette année, l'emploi s'est accru de 67 000 en Ontario.

Au Manitoba, l'emploi a augmenté de 5 000 en septembre, portant les gains d'emploi depuis le début de l'année à 8 000. Le niveau de l'emploi en Saskatchewan est demeuré stable en septembre et montre peu de changement par rapport à décembre 1995. En Alberta et en Colombie-Britannique, bien que l'emploi n'a pas varié significativement en septembre, il est en hausse de 33 000 et de 30 000 respectivement depuis le début de l'année.

Pertes d'emploi tant chez les adultes que chez les jeunes

La baisse de 47 000 emplois en septembre était répartie à la fois chez les adultes et chez les jeunes. Les adultes âgés de 25 ans et plus ont subi un déclin de 28 000 emplois, lequel faisait suite à une forte hausse de 70 000 le mois précédent. La croissance de l'emploi chez les adultes s'élève à 127 000 depuis le début de l'année.

L'emploi chez les jeunes âgés de 15 à 24 ans a diminué de 19 000 en septembre, portant à 21 000 la baisse de l'emploi chez ce groupe depuis décembre 1995.

Drop in full-time employment

Full-time employment dropped by 86,000 in September, wiping out the August increase of 75,000 and cutting this year's total gains in half. Full-time employment gains since the beginning of the year total 85,000, split equally between males and females.

Part-time employment was up 39,000 in September, with three quarters of the gain among women. There are now 21,000 more part-time jobs than there were at the beginning of the year.

Drop in private sector employees

In September, employment in the private sector was down as the number of employees fell by 79,000 while self-employment increased by 33,000. Employment in the public sector was unchanged in September. Since the beginning of the year, employment in the private sector has increased by 153,000 with the number of employees increasing by 129,000 (+1.4%) and the number of self-employed up 24,000 (+1.1%). Employment in the public sector has fallen by 45,000 (-2.1%) since December 1995.

Self-employed workers include working owners of incorporated or unincorporated businesses, who work for themselves, with or without paid help. Unpaid family workers are included in this group.

The public sector includes employees working for the federal government, a provincial or local government, an agency or other government body, a Crown corporation or a government-owned institution such as a school or hospital.

Phasing in the new LFS questionnaire

Over the past few years, extensive consultation with the survey's user community has led to the design of a new questionnaire that will provide much sought-after monthly information on issues such as wages, union status, job turnover, identification of seasonal and other temporary jobs. Beginning September 1996, all households newly rotating into the sample (about 10,000 each month) receive the new questionnaire. By January 1997, the new questionnaire will be fully implemented.

Chute de l'emploi à temps plein

L'emploi à temps plein a connu un déclin de 86 000 en septembre, annulant complètement le gain de 75 000 survenu en août et coupant de moitié les gains enregistrés depuis le début de l'année. Ceux-ci s'élèvent maintenant à 85 000, répartis également entre les hommes et les femmes.

L'emploi à temps partiel s'est accru de 39 000 en septembre, trois de ces emplois sur quatre étant allés aux femmes. Depuis décembre 1995, 21 000 emplois à temps partiel se sont ajoutés au marché du travail.

Fléchissement de l'emploi chez les employés du secteur privé

En septembre, l'emploi dans le secteur privé était à la baisse alors que le nombre d'employés fléchissait de 79 000 et celui des travailleurs indépendants augmentait de 33 000. L'emploi dans le secteur public, quant à lui, n'a pas varié en septembre. Depuis le début de l'année, l'emploi dans le secteur privé s'est accru de 153 000 alors que le nombre d'employés augmentait de 129 000 (+1,4 %) et celui des travailleurs indépendants de 24 000 (+1,1 %). Le secteur public a perdu 45 000 (-2,1 %) emplois depuis décembre 1995.

Les travailleurs indépendants comprennent les propriétaires d'entreprises, constituées ou non constituées en société, qui travaillent à leur propre compte et qui ont ou n'ont pas d'employés. Ce groupe comprend aussi les travailleurs familiaux non rémunérés.

Le secteur public comprend les employés travaillant pour l'administration fédérale, provinciale où locale, pour une agence ou autre service gouvernemental, pour une compagnie de la couronne ou pour des établissements dont le propriétaire est le gouvernement tels les écoles et les hopitaux.

Introduction du nouveau questionnaire

Ces dernières années, il s'est tenu des consultations exhaustives auprès des utilisateurs de l'enquête en vue de remanier le questionnaire de façon à obtenir des données mensuelles très en demande, notamment sur la rémunération, l'affiliation syndicale, le roulement de la main-d'œuvre, le travail saisonnier et les autres emplois temporaires. Depuis septembre 1996, le nouveau questionnaire est administré à tous les ménages qui entrent dans l'échantillon (environ 10 000 chaque mois). En janvier 1997, chaque interview se fera au moyen du nouveau questionnaire.

In addition to new content, structural changes have been introduced in the redesigned questionnaire to improve the identification of persons on temporary layoff. In order to estimate the impact of this improved measurement of temporary layoffs, a supplementary survey was conducted from August 1995 to August 1996. Based on the results of this survey, the temporary layoff changes should not significantly affect the analysis and interpretation of the unemployment rates from the LFS, since their impact is within the margins of the sampling variability. The article "Phasing in the New LFS Questionnaire: The Impact of Improved Measurement of Persons on Temporary Layoff" provides more details on the subject. En plus d'inclure du nouveau contenu, le questionnaire remanié comprend des modifications d'ordre structurel afin d'améliorer l'identification des personnes mises à pied temporairement. Afin d'estimer l'effet de cette mesure améliorée des mises à pied temporaires sur le taux de chômage, une enquête supplémentaire a été menée d'août 1995 à août 1996. Selon les résultats de cette enquête, les modifications touchant les mises à pied temporaires demeurent à l'intérieur des limites de la variabilité d'échantillonnage et ne devraient donc pas avoir d'incidence significative sur l'analyse et l'interprétation des taux de chômage découlant de l'EPA. L'article «Application progressive du nouveau questionnaire de l'EPA: effet de la mesure améliorée des mises à pied temporaires» fournit davantage de détails à ce sujet. Notes to Data Users

1. 
Employment, Seasonally Adjusted, Canada

Emploi désaisonnalisé selon certaines branches d'activités, Canada







