



March 1994 (preliminary)

Seasonally Adjusted

- For the week ending March 19, 1994, the number of people who received regular unemployment insurance benefits stood at 939,000, down 2.3% from a month earlier. This continues a downward trend in the number of beneficiaries since July 1992.
- Between February and March 1994, the number of people who received regular benefits declined in all jurisdictions except for the Northwest Territories. The largest decreases occurred in the Yukon (-5.9%), Saskatchewan (-5.2%) and Ontario (-4.8%).

Désaisonnalisées

- Pour la semaine se terminant le 19 mars 1994, le nombre de personnes ayant reçu des prestations ordinaires d'assurance-chômage s'est chiffré à 939 000, une diminution de 2,3% par rapport au mois dernier. Ceci poursuit une tendance à la baisse du nombre de bénéficiaires amorcé depuis juillet 1992.
- Entre février et mars 1994, le nombre de personnes recevant des prestations ordinaires a diminué partout au pays sauf dans les Territoires du Nord-Ouest. Les diminutions les plus importantes sont survenues au Yukon (-5,9%), en Saskatchewan (-5,2%) et en Ontario (-4,8%).

Unadjusted

- In March 1994, the total number of people who received unemployment insurance benefits was 1,362,000, down 11.4% from March 1993. Year-over-year, the number of men who collected benefits decreased 12.5% to 796,000, and the number of women who collected benefits 9.8% to 566,000.
- By Census Metropolitan Area, the table on the next page shows the year-over-year percentage changes in the number of beneficiaries.
- Unemployment insurance payments in March 1994 totalled \$1.8 billion, down 12.0% from March 1993. For the first quarter of 1994, \$5.1 billion was paid in benefits, a decline of 10.0% from the same period in 1993. Over the same period, the average weekly payment remained virtually unchanged at \$264.29.
- A total of 233,000 applications for unemployment insurance benefits were received in March 1994, down 10.9% from the same month a year ago. Since the start of the year, 785,000 claims have been received. This is a decrease of 6.8% from the same period a year ago.

Non-désaisonnalisées

- En mars 1994, le nombre total de personnes ayant reçu des prestations d'assurance-chômage s'est chiffré à 1 362 000, une diminution de 11.4% par rapport à mars 1993. Au cours de la même période, le nombre d'hommes ayant reçu des prestations a reculé de 12.5% pour se chiffrer à 796 000, alors que le nombre de femmes bénéficiaires a diminué de 9.8% pour s'établir à 566 000.
- Le tableau de la page suivante présente la variation annuelle du nombre de bénéficiaires par régions métropolitaines de recensement.
- Les montants déboursés par le Régime d'assurance-chômage en mars 1994 se sont chiffrés à 1,8 milliards\$, en baisse de 12.0% par rapport à mars 1993. Au cours du premier trimestre de 1994, ces montants ont totalisé 5,1 milliards\$ en baisse de 10.0% par rapport au premier trimestre de 1993. Au cours de la même période, le montant des prestations hebdomadaires moyennes est demeuré pratiquement inchangé à 264,29\$.
- Un total de 233 000 demandes de prestations d'assurance-chômage ont été reçues en mars 1994, une baisse de 10,9% par rapport à mars 1993. Depuis le début de 1994, un total de 785,000 demandes ont été reçues, une diminution de 6,8% par rapport à la même période l'an dernier.

Notes to Data Users

The number of beneficiaries represents a count of persons who qualified for unemployment insurance benefits during the Labour Force Survey reference week, usually containing the 15th day of the month.

Benefits paid, number of benefit weeks, and number of claims received, relate to a complete calendar month. It should be noted that these data are affected by the number of working days available during the reference month to process claims and to pay benefits. In making short-term comparisons it is not uncommon to observe different trends between these data and the number of beneficiaries.

For beneficiaries, preliminary data are shown for the two most recent months. All other data are final and, generally, are not subject to revisions. Starting with January 1987, the Census Division beneficiaries data (Matrices 5708-5717) have been tabulated according to the 1986 Standard Geographical Classification.

Please note, the number of beneficiaries shown under "fishing" now includes year-round fishermen. Also, beneficiaries identified as receiving "parental/adoption" benefits includes persons receiving benefits available to natural or adoptive parents.

Monthly unemployment insurance statistics are also available on **CANSIM**: Matrices 26 (series 1.6), 5700-5717, 5735, and 5736. The last two matrices are new; they contain monthly data, starting in January 1984, on beneficiaries by sex and Census Metropolitan Areas (CMA) or Census Agglomerations (CA).

Information about the unemployment insurance program, definitions, references and historical data are published in the **Annual Supplement** (Catalogue 73-202S), included with a subscription to the monthly report. Unpublished data are also available on request, including beneficiaries statistics for small areas as defined by data users.

Notes aux utilisateurs des données

Le nombre de bénéficiaires représente l'ensemble des personnes admissibles aux prestations d'assurance-chômage pour la semaine de référence de l'enquête sur la population active qui comprend habituellement le 15^e jour du mois.

Les prestations versées, le nombre de semaines de prestations et le nombre de demandes reçues sont des données fondées sur l'ensemble du mois. Le nombre de jours ouvrables qui sont disponibles durant le mois pour le traitement des demandes et pour le paiement des prestations influence donc le niveau et la tendance de ces données. Lorsqu'on compare les variations mensuelles de ces données, il est donc fréquent d'observer des tendances différentes avec le nombre de bénéficiaires.

Les deux derniers mois de données sur les bénéficiaires sont préliminaires. Toutes les autres données sont finales et ne font généralement pas l'objet d'une révision. À partir de janvier 1987, les données des bénéficiaires d'assurance-chômage par division de recensement (matrices 5708 à 5717) sont basées sur la classification géographique de 1986.

Veuillez prendre note que le nombre de bénéficiaires présenté sous le titre "pêche" renferme maintenant les pêcheurs à longueur d'année. En outre, les bénéficiaires identifiés sous "parentale/adoption" représentent les personnes ayant reçu des prestations offertes aux parents naturels ou adoptifs.

Les statistiques mensuelles de l'assurance-chômage sont aussi disponibles sur **CANSIM** dans la matrice 26, série 1.6 et dans les matrices 5700-5717, ainsi que 5735-5736. Ces deux dernières matrices contiennent de nouvelles séries, remontant à janvier 1984, des bénéficiaires d'assurance-chômage selon le sexe et la région métropolitaine de recensement (RMR) ou l'agglomération de recensement (AR).

De l'information à propos du programme de l'assurance-chômage, que ce soit des définitions, des références ou des données historiques sont publiées dans le **Supplément annuel** (n° 73-202S au catalogue), compris dans le prix de l'abonnement au rapport mensuel. Des données inédites sont également disponibles sur demande, y compris des statistiques sur les bénéficiaires pour toute région définie par le requérant.

Endnotes

- ¹ The Average Weekly Payment is calculated by dividing the "gross amount" by the "number of weeks paid" except for Training and Self-employment Assistance benefits where the amount related to Course Costs and Project costs are excluded. The "gross amount" includes benefits previously paid, income tax deductions and lump sum payments. Because the "gross amount" is not adjusted, the calculated Average Weekly Payment can exceed the maximum benefit level. If this occurs the average is reduced to the applicable maximum weekly benefit.
- ² The monthly number of beneficiaries shown in this report include all claimants who received benefits for the Labour Force Survey reference week, usually containing the 15th day of the month. The annual number represent unduplicated counts of all persons who, during the course of a calendar year, received unemployment insurance benefits.
- ³ "Persons Covered by Unemployment Insurance" include all persons for whom there exists an employer-employee relationship, excepting workers who are low earners. The monthly estimates are derived by adding to the "employed paid workers", as measured by the Labour Force Survey, the strength of the Armed Forces and the number of beneficiaries. The annual data are estimates of persons who, during the year, contributed towards the unemployment insurance program.
- ⁴ Includes claims with disqualifications and disentitlements, and claims previously not allowed.
- ⁵ Parental benefits are payable up to 10 weeks to the mother and/or father of a newborn or adopted child. Claimants eligible for parental benefits after maternity benefits are not counted in the number of initial claims allowed for parental benefits.
- ⁶ The number of disqualifications and disentitlements shown are for conditions which were imposed when a claim was made. Up to two disqualifications or disentitlements are counted in the statistics; thus, the data reflect the number of disqualifications and disentitlements and not the number of persons affected. Also, the data are not revised when a person's status changes and when he or she becomes eligible to receive benefits.
- ⁷ Trainees on courses approved by Employment and Immigration Canada. The amount of monies reported for Training include benefits paid to individuals, supplementary allowances and monies paid to schools and colleges to train beneficiaries.
