





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ANNUAL REPORT ON CURRENT BENEFIT YEARS UNDER THE UNEMPLOYMENT INSURANCE ACT
1947

The basic material for this report was supplied to the Dominion Bureau of Statistics by the Unemployment Insurance Commission through the Treasury Offices.

PART I - THE INSURED POPULATION :

The term "insured population" can be given a variety of meanings, each of which is useful for certain purposes. For example, the number of insurance books and contribution cards issued in a year may be used or, for another purpose, the number of persons who have satisfied the minimum contribution requirements necessary to establish benefit rights under the Act may be the most useful concept, whereas the number of persons employed in insurable employment at a given time is most appropriate in other connections. It is this last concept that is used in Tables A, B and C of the present report.

Unemployment Insurance books and contribution cards are renewed each April 1st, providing a count of persons actively engaged in insured employment or unemployed but reporting to a local office for one reason or another. To secure information on the personal and employment characteristics of insured persons, the sex, year of birth, occupation and industry of a ten percent sample of renewals and new entrants are obtained. The sample is composed of all those whose insurance numbers end in 4.

Tables A, B and C present tabulations of returns for the sample (representing 2,280,200 persons) received at the Dominion Bureau of Statistics covering the book renewal in April 1947 and new entrants into insurance, having sample numbers, during April. This is substantially the population from which those establishing benefit years during 1947 could have been drawn. Since a minimum of 180 days' contributions during the past two years is required to establish a benefit year, those entering insurance after May 31st, 1947 could not qualify during that calendar year. Those who renewed their books after April 30th have obviously been outside insured employment for a while and many of them customarily engage in insurable employment for only a portion of each year. Classifications by occupation, sex and province are presented in Table A, by industry, sex and age in Table B and by industry, sex and province in Table C. Comparable data for persons who establish benefit years and the benefit days paid to them in 1947 will be found in Tables 11-16 of Part II of this report.

PART II - BENEFIT YEARS :

The "benefit year" is a device whereby the benefit rights, if

any, available to an insured person can be computed at any time. When an insured person becomes unemployed and makes application, a benefit year is established for him if he satisfies the following four statutory conditions :

1. - that at least 180 days' contributions have been paid in his behalf during the two years immediately preceding the date of his claim and, in the case of his second and all subsequent benefit years, at least 60 days' contributions have been paid in his behalf since the commencement of his immediately preceding benefit year;
2. - that he has made application in the prescribed manner;
3. - that he is at least 16 years of age;
4. - that more than half of the contributions paid in his behalf during the year immediately preceding the date of his claim have been paid at a rate other than the minimum rate ("class 0") provided in the first schedule of the Unemployment Insurance Act.

For each benefit year established, the duration of benefit authorized is computed on the basis of the number of days contributed in the immediately preceding five years and days benefit drawn in the immediately preceding three years; and the daily rate of benefit is determined from the daily average contributions paid during the preceding two years and on whether or not the claimant has a dependent within the meaning of the Act. The establishment of a benefit year for a claimant does not necessarily mean that he is entitled to draw benefit immediately. It merely means that he has considered himself to be unemployed, has made application and has fulfilled the minimum requirements of the Act for the establishing of benefit rights (the above four statutory conditions).

Entitlement to benefit during each period of unemployment is determined on the basis of the circumstances of the case. The Unemployment Insurance Act is designed to provide protection against the hazard of involuntary unemployment for those whose contribution records indicate more than merely nominal attachment to the insured working force. When a benefit year has been established, the benefit rights authorized may be drawn upon during successive periods of unemployment until either the rights authorized have been exhausted or twelve months have passed, whichever occurs first. When a claimant's benefit year terminates he may immediately establish another if he can fulfill the four basic statutory conditions.

The receipt of benefit at any time depends, however, upon other conditions. The first nine days of proven unemployment in any benefit year are not compensated, and the first day of unemployment in a claim week is not compensable unless it immediately follows or forms part of a full week of unemployment. Apart from these circumstances, to be eligible for benefit the claimant must periodically declare that he is unemployed, is capable of and available for work and unable to find suitable employment. To be

considered unemployed within the meaning of the Act a person must have become separated from his previous employment or have been put on short time. He is deemed to be employed during any period for which he has received dismissal pay or payment in lieu of notice and, even though separated from his major employment, if he earns more than an average of one dollar and fifty cents a day in some subsidiary employment.

During a period of illness, own-account employment or voluntary vacation a claimant is considered not capable of or not available for employment. Voluntarily leaving the former employment without just cause, discharge on account of his own misconduct, refusal of an offer of suitable employment or neglecting to avail himself of an opportunity to work at suitable employment, render the claimant subject to disqualification from benefit for a period not exceeding six weeks, such a period being considered voluntary unemployment.

Significant attachment to the insured working force is usually indicated by the claimant's past contribution record. Thus the requirement that at least 180 days' contributions must have been recorded within the past two years and at least 60 days since the commencement of the immediately preceding benefit year. In addition, benefit cannot be paid to a person who is : an inmate of an institution supported wholly or partly out of public funds, not residing in Canada (with some exceptions) etc. The basic statutory conditions concerning those under 16 years of age and those whose contributions have been mainly in "Class O" are also pertinent when one considers attachment to the insured working force.

This brief summary of the conditions surrounding the payment of benefit is intended merely as an aid to those who desire to interpret and use the following tables. For a complete and strictly accurate understanding of these conditions reference should be made to the Unemployment Insurance Act as amended in October 1946 and the regulations passed by Order in Council under the authority of that statute.

There were ~~266,249~~ ^{266,249} ~~265,117~~ ^{265,117} benefit years established by ~~265,985~~ persons during 1947, while 512,191 persons had benefit years available during that calendar year (some benefit years established in 1946 having carried over into 1947) and 283,725 were paid benefit. Tables 1-19 of this report present some characteristics of those who established benefit years, those who drew benefit and those whose benefit years terminated during 1947.

Tables 1 to 4 represent summaries derived from the more detailed tables that follow. Table 1 is a very brief summary of the benefit days available and benefit days paid during 1947. Of the 94,125,968 days available, 15,829,578 days, or about 17 percent, were paid. It would appear, therefore, that the benefit rights available to claimants during 1947 were more than sufficient, on the whole, to meet the need for them. In Table 2, the number of benefit years established, benefit ~~years~~ ^{DAYS} authorized and number of persons establishing benefit years are classified by province. The ~~266,249~~ ^{266,249} ~~265,117~~ ^{265,117} benefit years established in 1947 involved ~~265,985~~ persons, 1,152 of whom established two benefit years during that calendar year. Table 3 presents a summary of the number of persons with current benefit years (including those with a benefit

year established in 1946 that was still available during some part of 1947), persons who drew benefit, benefit days paid and amount of benefit paid, by sex and province, during 1947. The number of days benefit paid and amount of benefit paid as recorded in Table 5 are obtained from the punch cards set up for each benefit year established. The daily rate of benefit and days authorized are punched at the time the benefit year is established and the days benefit paid are obtained and punched either when the benefit year terminates or at the end of the calendar year in the case of those still in existence at December 31st. Amount of benefit paid is then estimated by sorting the punch cards and obtaining a tabulator total for days paid at each daily rate. This estimate will never agree exactly with the actual amount out of the unemployment insurance fund since the daily rate of benefit for some claimants will change during the life of the benefit year as the claimant gains or loses a dependent within the meaning of the Act. Since many of these changes are compensatory, however, the difference due to this factor should be negligible. As a matter of fact, benefit payments in 1947 amounted to \$52,039,540 according to the monthly statements from the Treasury Offices and \$51,156,965 as estimated from the punch cards and shown in Table 5. The difference between these two figures is 2.8 percent, which is a negligible difference for all practical purposes. The method used in Table 5 is the only means available for obtaining the days benefit paid and amount of benefit paid by sex and, if needed, by age, dependency status and other factors.

Persons with benefit years current during 1947 are classified, in Table 4, according to whether or not they have a dependent within the meaning of the Act at the time the benefit year was established. Since a person's status with respect to dependents is subject to change over time, it is felt that satisfactory results are obtained by recording the status in this manner. The status of those who established more than one benefit year during 1947 is determined at the time the first benefit year came into being.

In Tables 5 and 6 persons with benefit years current during 1947 and the benefit days paid to them are classified according to number of benefit days paid, sex and province. Of the 388,568 males and 125,623 females with benefit years current in 1947, 174,299 males, 45 percent, and 54,167 females, 44 percent, drew no benefit. The largest class of males and females drew from 5-9 days benefit and the second largest class drew from 1 to 4 days. Thus 55 percent of the males and 52 percent of the females were paid either no benefit or less than 10 days. In 1946, 27 percent of the males and 51 percent of the females drew no benefit and 35 percent of the males and 59 percent of the females drew either no benefit or less than 10 days.

Those who drew benefit in 1947 and the benefit days paid to them are classified in Tables 7 and 8 by daily rate of benefit, sex and dependency status, for the provinces. The daily rate of benefit is determined by the daily average contribution paid on behalf of an insured person during the two years immediately preceding the date of his claim and on whether or not he has a dependent as defined in the Act. The insured person's share of the daily contribution amounts to 1.5, 2.0, 2.5, 3.0,

3.5, 4.0, 5.0, or 6.0 cents according to his earnings. His daily average contribution over the two-year period is multiplied by 34 if he has no dependent or by 40 if he has a dependent, to determine his daily rate of benefit. For example, a claimant who has contributed at the rate of 6.0 cents a day and has a dependent would be entitled to benefit at the rate of \$2.40 a day and, from the schedule of contributions given in the Act, it is known that his weekly earnings during the two-year period have amounted to \$26 or more. Since a person's earnings often fluctuate over a period, the daily average contribution need not correspond with any one of the schedule rates.

Table 7 shows that during 1947 the majority (57 percent) of male beneficiaries having a dependent were paid benefit at the maximum rate of \$2.40 a day while 50 percent of males without a dependent were paid at a rate falling between \$2.00 and \$2.09 (the maximum of those without a dependent being \$2.05) indicating average weekly earnings of \$26 or more. At the same time 94 percent of males with dependents were paid \$2.00 or more a day and 79 percent of males without a dependent received \$1.70 or more a day, indicating in each case average weekly earnings of \$20 or more.

A much lower proportion of female than of male beneficiaries is paid at the higher benefit rates. This is due partly to the fact that only a small proportion of female beneficiaries (5 percent) is paid at the rate for those having a dependent but lower average weekly earnings for females are also indicated. For example, 10 percent of females having a dependent and 9 percent with no dependent were paid at the maximum rates of \$2.40 and \$2.00-\$2.09, although an additional 19 percent of those with a dependent were paid from \$2.10 to \$2.39 and so must have had earnings of \$26 a week or more for part of the two-year period. But more females without a dependent (17 percent) were paid at rates between \$1.50 and \$1.59 as at those between \$2.00 and \$2.09 (9 percent) and other groups were significantly large, such as that paid between \$1.20-\$1.29 (10 percent), \$1.40-\$1.49 (10 percent), \$1.50-\$1.59 (9 percent), \$1.60-\$1.69 (9 percent) and \$1.70-\$1.79 (14 percent). One reason for these lower earnings is apparent in Table 9 where the generally younger ages of females who established benefit years is evident.

Tables 9-16 include only those persons who established benefit years during the calendar year 1947 and the benefit days paid on those benefit years during that calendar year. Persons who established benefit years and the benefit days paid are classified in Tables 9 and 10 by age group, in Table II and 12 by industry and age, and in Tables 15 and 14 by industry and province, in the same categories as given in Tables B and C for the insured population. In Tables 15 and 16 the persons who established benefit years and the benefit days paid on them during 1947 are classified by occupation, sex and province, being classified on the same basis used for the insured population in Table A.

Tables 17-19 are concerned with the benefit years that terminated in 1947. A benefit year terminates either twelve months after it was established or when the benefit rights available have been exhausted, whichever occurs first. In the former case the benefit year is said to terminate by lapsing and in the latter case by exhaustion. Benefit years terminated during 1947 are classified, in Table 17, by number of benefit days authorized and benefit days paid. This gives an indication of the extent to which the authorized benefit rights were utilized at the time of termination. In Table 18 the benefit years terminated are classified by daily rate of benefit, number of benefit days paid, sex and dependency status. Total benefit years terminated and those terminated by exhaustion are classified in Table 19 by age group and sex.




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
