

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ANNUAL REPORT ON CURRENT BENEFIT YEARS  
UNDER THE UNEMPLOYMENT INSURANCE ACT

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This is the final statistical report, covering the calendar year 1948, on benefit years established and terminated under the Unemployment Insurance Act and contains tables exhibiting the personal characteristics of benefit claimants as well as benefit days paid within many detailed categories. The basic material for this report was supplied to the Dominion Bureau of Statistics by the Unemployment Insurance Commission through the Treasury Offices.

PART 1 - THE INSURED POPULATION :

In a social insurance program such as unemployment insurance which is designed to meet one of the hazards facing industrial employees, the insured population can be viewed from a number of different conceptions. For example, the number of contributors in a given period such as a year may be considered as representing the insured population or, for another purpose, the number of persons who have satisfied the minimum contribution requirements necessary to establish benefit rights under the Act may be the most useful concept. From another viewpoint the number of persons employed in insurable employment at a given time along with those on claim is most appropriate. The present report contains data on the insured population according to this last conception.

Unemployment insurance books and contribution cards are renewed each April 1st, providing a count of persons actively engaged in insured employment or currently reporting to a local office of the Commission either because they are on claim or for any other reason. In order to secure information on the personal and employment characteristics of insured persons, the sex, year of birth, occupation and industry of a ten percent sample of renewals and

new entrants are obtained. The sample is made up of those whose insurance numbers end in "4".

The information tabulated in Tables A, B, and C represents returns received at the Dominion Bureau of Statistics covering the book renewal in April, 1948 and new entrants into insurance, having sample numbers, during April. This is substantially the population from which those establishing benefit years during 1948 could have been drawn. A minimum of 180 days contributions during the two years immediately preceding the claim is required to establish a benefit year, so that those entering insurance after May 31st, 1948 could not qualify during that calendar year. Those who renewed their insurance books after April 30th have obviously been outside of insured employment for the time and many of them customarily engaged in insurable employment for only a portion of each year. Classifications by occupations, sex and province are presented in Table A; by industry, sex and age in Table B; and by industry, sex and province in Table C. Comparable data for persons who established benefit years and the benefit days paid to them in 1948 will be found in Tables 11 to 16 of Part 11 of this report.

#### PART 11 - BENEFIT YEARS :

The "benefit year" is a device whereby the benefit rights, if any, available to an insured person can be computed at any time. When an insured person becomes unemployed and makes application, a benefit year is established for him if he satisfies the following four statutory conditions :

1. - that at least 180 days' contributions have been paid in his behalf during the two years immediately preceding the date of his claim and, in the case of his second and all subsequent benefit years, at least 60 days' contributions have been paid in his behalf since the commencement of his immediately preceding benefit year;
2. - that he has made application in the prescribed manner;

3. - that he is at least 16 years of age;
4. - that more than half of the contributions paid in his behalf during the year immediately preceding the date of his claim have been paid at a rate other than the minimum rate ("Class 0") provided in the first schedule of the Unemployment Insurance Act.

For each benefit year established, the duration of benefit authorized is computed on the basis of the number of days contributed in the immediately preceding five years and days benefit drawn in the immediately preceding three years; and the daily rate of benefit is determined from the daily average contributions paid during the preceding two years and on whether or not the claimant has a dependent within the meaning of the Act. The establishment of a benefit year for a claimant does not necessarily mean that he is entitled to draw benefit immediately. It merely means that he has considered himself to be unemployed, has made application and has fulfilled the minimum requirements of the Act for the establishing of benefit rights (the above four statutory conditions).

Entitlement to benefit during each period of unemployment is determined on the basis of the circumstances of the case. The Unemployment Insurance Act is designed to provide protection against the hazard of involuntary unemployment for those whose contribution records indicate more than merely nominal attachment to the insured working force. When a benefit year has been established, the benefit rights authorized may be drawn upon during successive periods of unemployment until either the rights authorized have been exhausted or twelve months have passed, whichever occurs first. When a claimant's benefit year terminates he may immediately establish another if he can fulfill the four basic statutory conditions.

The receipt of benefit at any time depends, however, upon other conditions. The first nine days of proven unemployment in any benefit year are not compensated, and the first day of unemployment in a claim week

is not compensable unless it immediately follows or forms part of a full week of unemployment. Apart from these circumstances, to be eligible for benefit the claimant must periodically declare that he is unemployed, is capable of and available for work and unable to find suitable employment. To be considered unemployed within the meaning of the Act a person must have become separated from his previous employment or have been put on short time. He is deemed to be employed during any period for which he has received dismissal pay or payment in lieu of notice and, even though separated from his major employment, if he earns more than an average of one dollar and fifty cents a day in some subsidiary employment.

During a period of illness, own-account employment or voluntary vacation a claimant is considered not capable of or not available for employment. Voluntarily leaving the former employment without just cause, discharge on account of his own misconduct, refusal of an offer of suitable employment or neglecting to avail himself of an opportunity to work at suitable employment, render the claimant subject to disqualification from benefit for a period not exceeding six weeks, such a period being considered voluntary unemployment.

Significant attachment to the insured working force is usually indicated by the claimant's past contribution record. Thus the requirement that at least 180 days' contributions must have been recorded within the past two years and at least 60 days since the commencement of the immediately preceding benefit year. In addition, benefit cannot be paid to a person who is : an inmate of an institution supported wholly or partly out of public funds, not residing in Canada (with some exceptions) etc. The basic statutory conditions concerning those under 16 years of age and those whose contributions have been mainly in "Class 0" are also pertinent when one considers attachment to the insured working force.

This brief summary of the conditions surrounding the payment of benefit is intended merely as an aid to those who desire to interpret and use the following tables. For a complete and strictly accurate understanding of these conditions reference should be made to the Unemployment Insurance Act as amended in October 1948 and the regulations passed by Order-in-Council under the authority of that statute.

There were 395,637 benefit years established in 1948 by 392,128 individual claimants (3,509 of whom established two benefit years in that calendar year). A total of 595,556 persons had benefit years available during 1948 (some 200,000 benefit years established in 1947 having carried over into 1948) of whom 387,770 received one or more benefit payments during the calendar year. Tables 1 to 19 of this report present some details regarding the benefit years established and terminated as well as personal and employment characteristics of those who established benefit years, those with benefit rights available, those who drew benefit, and those whose benefit years terminated.

Tables 1 to 4 are summaries derived from the more detailed tables that follow. A very brief summary of the number of benefit days available and benefit days used in 1948 (Table 1) indicates that of a total of 106,600,000 benefit days available in 1948 only some 20,279,000 (19.02 p.c.) were used. A significantly greater number, 35,226,000, lapsed because they remained unused twelve months after their establishment. On the whole, then, the benefit rights available under the Unemployment Insurance Act in 1948 were much more than adequate to meet the requirements for them.

In Table 2 the number of benefit years established, the number of benefit days authorized and the number of persons (male and female) establishing first and second benefit years are classified by province. In 1948, 395,637 benefit years were established and

64,235,269 benefit days authorized. Of the benefit years established, 392,128 were in respect of persons establishing their first benefit year in the calendar year whereas only 3,509 benefit years were established as second benefit years.

In Table 3 persons with current benefit years, persons drawing benefit, benefit days paid and total amount of benefit paid are classified by sex and province. Of a total of 595,556 persons with current benefit years 387,770 drew benefit for 20,279,808 days, in total amounting to \$40,469,125. The number of days benefit paid and amount of benefit paid as recorded in Table 3 are obtained from the punch card set up for each benefit year established. The daily rate of benefit and days authorized are punched at the time the benefit year is established and the days benefit paid are obtained and punched either when the benefit year terminates or at the end of the calendar year in the case of those still in existence at December 31st. Amount of benefit paid is then estimated by sorting the punch cards and obtaining a tabular total for days paid at each daily rate. This estimate will never agree exactly with the actual amount paid out of the Unemployment Insurance Fund since the daily rate of benefit for some claimants will change during the life of the benefit year as the claimant gains or loses a dependent within the meaning of the Act. Since many of these changes are compensatory, however, the difference due to this factor should be negligible.

Table 4 lists the dependency status of persons with current benefit years and the number of benefit days paid to these persons according to sex and province. Of the total of 595,556 persons with current benefit years, 258,648 or about 43 percent had dependents. Males with dependents numbered 251,084 or 55 percent of all males while females in this category numbered only 7,564 or about 6 percent of all females with current benefit years. It should be noted in this connection that on October 4, 1948, an amendment to the Act was passed increasing the rate of benefit to persons with dependents.

In Tables 5 and 6 persons with benefit years current during 1948 and the benefit days paid to them are classified according to number of benefit days paid, sex and province. Of the 459,539 males with current benefit years no benefit was paid in respect of 156,885 or 34.14 percent. Females with current benefit years numbered 136,017 and of these 50,901 or 37.42 percent drew no benefit. For both males and females the largest class of persons drawing benefit drew from 5 to 9 days. In total 46 percent of males and 46 percent of females in 1948 as compared to 55 percent of males and 52 percent of females with current benefit years in 1947 either drew no benefit or drew for less than 10 days.

Tables 7 and 8 contain information regarding the number of beneficiaries, and benefit days paid respectively classified by daily rate of benefit, sex and dependency status for Canada and for the provinces. The daily rate of benefit is determined on the basis of the average daily rate of contributions over the two-year period preceding the date of the claim and on whether or not the claimant has a dependent. Thus the daily rate of benefit for a person without dependents is 34 times the average daily contribution made on behalf of the employee over the two-year period preceding the claim or 40 times the average daily contribution made on behalf of a person with dependents. From Table 7 it is evident that over half (about 52 percent) of males with dependents were in the group receiving a daily rate of benefit between \$2.40 and \$2.49. Females with dependents were not concentrated in any one group to the same degree, the largest percentage (11 percent) being in the \$2.00 to \$2.09 a day group. Male beneficiaries without dependents, in part because they consisted in the main of younger and less experienced workers, were concentrated in the group receiving a lower daily rate of benefit (\$2.00 to \$2.09) than male beneficiaries with dependents. Similarly the largest percentage female beneficiaries were the group receiving a daily rate of benefit between \$1.30 to \$1.39.

Tables 9 to 17 inclusive refer to persons establishing benefit years and benefit days paid on benefit years established.

Persons establishing benefit years and benefit days paid on benefit years established are classified by age group, sex and province in Tables 9 and 10; by industry, sex, and age group in Tables 13 and 14 and occupation, sex and province in Tables 15 and 16.

Tables 17 - 19 contain information regarding benefit years terminating in 1948. When a benefit year is established as described above it continues in existence for a period of 12 months unless it terminates through exhaustion of benefit rights. In Table 17 the number of benefit years terminated during the year are classified by maximum duration of benefit authorized and days paid by sex. Examination of this Table shows that the percentage of cases in which no benefit is paid tends to vary inversely with the number of benefit days authorized. This suggests that, to the extent that the contribution history of the claimant indicates a pattern of steady employment, the claimant is more likely to become reemployed before the expiration of the waiting period, i.e. before benefit actually becomes payable.


