


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

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TEACHERS' SALARIES AND QUALIFICATIONS IN EIGHT PROVINCES, 1948
GENERAL SUMMARY

The tables in this bulletin have been published annually in a similar form since 1939 for eight provinces (Quebec excepted). All full-time teachers in the publicly-controlled elementary and secondary schools are included excepting the teachers in vocational schools in New Brunswick. Also included are supervisors and directors of special subjects but not superintendents or inspectors. These supervisors are rarely employed outside the larger cities.

In the tabulation by certificate all academic teachers with an academic background of the level of senior matriculation or higher, and one year professional training, are classified as first class or higher. Class II indicated the junior matriculation level and one year professional training. Class III indicates less academic and professional training. A few may be near emergency certificates and some are older teachers of long experience. Permit includes those persons without any professional training who have been given permission to teach, usually for one year only, and those who have attended a normal school short course. These latter are required to take further training at the end of a year's teaching. All vocational school certificates or certificates for special subjects or classes are classified as special.

In classifying by location, rural includes all schools located outside an incorporated city, town or village. As a result the class of more-than-one room rural contains many teachers in large suburban schools.

The statutory requirements regarding size for urban municipalities in British Columbia differ so much from those of the other provinces that a reclassification has been made. Cities now include all centres of 10,000 population or over. One-room rural includes all one-room schools outside these centres. More-than-one-room includes all schools of two to five classrooms. The remainder, schools of 6 classrooms or over, are classified in towns and villages.

TEACHERS BY LOCATION The following table gives a picture of the distribution of the teachers in each province in 1948 by location or type of school.

The three Maritime Provinces, Manitoba and Saskatchewan show up as preponderantly rural. In Alberta the division is nearly equal, while in British Columbia and Ontario most of the teachers are in urban schools; in fact in British Columbia almost half are in "cities", centres of over 10,000 population.

INCREASING NUMBERS

The total number of teachers has been increasing since 1944, in keeping with enrolments. In that year there were 49,022 teachers in the eight provinces (some 75,000 if Quebec is included). This had risen to 53,472 in 1948, an increase of 11 p.c. and it is estimated the total may reach 65,000 by 1953. For 9 provinces the total may be 118,000 by 1960, an increase of 58 p.c. over 1944. So far the increase in staff has been least in Prince Edward Island, Saskatchewan and Alberta, and greatest in British Columbia where there has been an increase of 25 p.c. in four years.

PROPORTION OF MEN AND WOMEN

In 1944 and 1945 the proportion of men in the profession was at the low point of 20 p.c. Since then there has been a steady increase to 27 p.c. in 1948, which is not far from the high level of 30 p.c. in 1940. This trend is most marked in Saskatchewan where the percentage of men has risen by 10 since 1944, and least marked in Nova Scotia and New Brunswick where the increase was 4 p.c.

As women replaced men during the war their numbers increased 3,769 between 1939 and 1944. From then through 1947 the numbers decreased 487, then increased by 612 in 1948. Available data suggest that 25 p.c. of the women teachers in the eight provinces are married. This is exclusive of the Roman Catholic Separate schools of Ontario where there are many religious teachers.

PROPORTION OF UNIVERSITY GRADUATES

The proportion of teachers who are university graduates increased from 17 p.c. in 1939 to 19 p.c. in 1948 due to small increases in four provinces. Elsewhere the proportion decreased slightly. The data for 1943 show there was a decrease during the war in all provinces except British Columbia.

A clearer picture of the situation within the provinces and a better basis for comparison between provinces is afforded by a breakdown on the basis of location for the year 1948.

Thirty-five percent of teachers in city schools are university graduates, in Saskatchewan 54 p.c. In cities the proportion of secondary school teachers, most of whom have degrees, is higher than outside. Cities can afford to attract teachers with degrees and offer them opportunities for advancement. Further, it often is easier for a teacher in a city to proceed towards a degree extramurally than for one outside.

With the exception of Ontario and British Columbia the proportion in towns and villages is considerably lower, and the range between the lowest and the highest considerably less.

The comparison between provinces is weakest in the case of the more-than-one room rural schools since this group is made up of larger rural schools, semi-urban schools which are more akin to towns in type and suburban schools which are located in the outskirts of the larger cities.

The proportion in the rural schools is very small. Only one province has over 2 p.c. university graduates, and three provinces show less than 1 p.c.

Several things contribute to the low percentages in Prince Edward Island. More than half the teachers are in one-room rural schools, and urban schools are comparatively small. The only publicly-controlled secondary school is Prince of Wales College and this is not included in the tables of this bulletin. Consequently the incentives and opportunities are lacking. Further, to obtain a degree, most teachers must go off the Island and this leads to opportunities for employment elsewhere.

SUBSTANDARD
TEACHERS

For some years the minimum requirements for standard teachers' certificates in the various provinces have been at least junior matriculation level and one year of professional training and sometimes more.

Any authorization to teach based on lower qualifications is therefore below present day standards.

As would be expected, most of those teaching with little or no professional training are in rural schools, and it is of interest to examine this situation. The following table gives the percentages of those teaching in one-room rural schools who have less than a Class II certificate, the great majority with a permit. Unfortunately data prior to 1943 are insufficient to show earlier years.

In each province there are a number of older teachers of considerable experience with low grade permanent certificates. Except in Nova Scotia, their numbers are hardly sufficient to materially effect percentages given in the table. Prior to 1933 Nova Scotia issued a Class C certificate requiring Grade X or XI academic standing and 6 months at normal school. Some raised their certificates, others dropped out of the profession so that by 1942 their numbers had dwindled to 451. During the next few years over 300 returned to help meet the teacher shortage. With these deducted the percentages with lower qualifications from 1943 to 1948 for Nova Scotia would be 14, 16, 32, 40, 37 and 37 respectively.

Since certificates are not interchangeable between provinces the number of permits contains some who are fully-trained teachers of another province, often with considerable experience. Forty-three percent of teachers in one-room rural schools in British Columbia have extra-provincial experience; this amounts to 134 p.c. of the permits. In Alberta these teachers amount to 13 p.c. of the rural teachers and 71 p.c. of the permits. In Ontario at least one third of the permit

teachers have one year or more of normal school training. (In the other provinces the percentages are much lower, 3 p.c. to 8 p.c. of the rural staff.) This means that the proportion of permit teachers as an indication of untrained staff must be discounted somewhat in the three provinces mentioned.

In plotting the percentages of the above table on Chart 1 the provinces are divided into three groups according to the average of the percentages for the six years. New Brunswick is separated from the middle group mainly to maintain clarity in the picture. Also, though the percentages for New Brunswick are in the class of the middle group the variation between the extremes is only 11 p.c.

What happened in Nova Scotia, happened in Prince Edward Island at a much lower level. There was a rapid rise in the proportion of substandard teachers from 1943 to 1946, a small increase between 1946 and 1947 and a definite decline between 1947 and 1948.

The picture for Alberta and Saskatchewan is very similar to that for the two Maritime provinces except that the decline is much more pronounced. In Manitoba the rapid rise in percentage was delayed a year and the decline has been only from 48 to 45 p.c. British Columbia has come nearest recovering to the 1943 situation. Compared with the other provinces the increase in Ontario was delayed two years and so far is only 10 p.c. above the level of 1945, the lowest of the six years.


1946 was the peak year for four and 1947 for three of the eight provinces. Since then there has been a definite improvement in all provinces except Ontario.

In 1948, on the basis of the total staff for eight provinces, 11.4 p.c. of the teachers were classified as Class III or permit. Making a reasonable allowance for the numbers of permit teachers who have a year's normal school training would lower to 10 p.c. the proportion of substandard teachers in the eight provinces. This is the same percentage as the estimate given for the United States in 1949. (1)

TURNOVER IN RURAL SCHOOLS Another problem most pronounced in rural schools is that of turnover. Each year a large proportion of the total staff leave their positions either to quit the profession or to seek new teaching positions. Some indication of the magnitude and variation of this annual upheaval may be obtained by expressing the numbers reporting one year or less in the present school as a percentage of the total number of teachers in the previous midsummer. The results are shown by the following table and illustrated in Chart 2. Again the provinces are grouped on the graph according to the averages for the six years.

1942-1947



At once it will be observed that in every one of these six years and for each of the seven provinces more than one-half of this group of teachers annually changed jobs, and in 1947 in one province the proportion amounted to over 75 p.c. This is a very serious disruption; the above figures are averages and there are certain areas in each province where the turnover is much higher. Another disturbing feature is that, except in two provinces, Saskatchewan and Prince Edward Island, the situation in 1947 was worse than in 1946 and practically no less than in the war years. Turnover in towns is less and in cities very much less than in rural areas.

It might be supposed that low salaries, a high percentage of unqualified teachers and a high rate of turnover would go together but if the data on these three are brought together this supposition is not substantiated.



Prince Edward Island with the lowest median salary also has a low percentage of unqualified teachers and comparatively low rate of turnover. Nova Scotia with a median salary \$53 greater has a much higher rate of turnover and the highest percentage of substandard teachers. Manitoba with a much higher median salary shows the highest rate of turnover and high percentage of unqualified teachers. British Columbia with the highest median salary has a rate of turnover equal to that of Saskatchewan where the median is \$400 less.

ANNUAL LOSS
FROM THE
PROFESSION

Data on teachers leaving the profession from three provinces show losses of 8 p.c., 13 p.c. and 13 p.c. respectively. An average annual loss of one-tenth for the eight provinces would probably be a conservative estimate. About 30 p.c. of these leave to get married. The proportion who leave to enter other occupations varies considerable but probably averages between 25 p.c. and 35 p.c. depending on the provincial economy, another 6 p.c. are superannuated. About the same proportion are lost through ill-health or death. Further training, teaching in private schools, leaving the province and returning to domestic work account for almost all of the remainder.

SALARY RANGES

Chart 3 illustrates the salary ranges in city, town and village, and one-room rural schools for each year from 1939 to 1948.

It has not been possible to establish the minimum salary for each year because of difficulties in eliminating part-time teachers. For this reason the lowest 1 p.c. has been removed. This still leaves very low salary figures. Of late years all the teachers near the bottom of the range have been religious. It is worth noting, however, that the lower limits as recorded on the graph are remarkably close for all schools and have moved up only some \$200 since 1939.

At the other extreme the maximum in all urban centres remained at \$5,000 till 1947. This meant that the highest salary a teacher in these 8 provinces could reach below an administrative post was \$5,000, and indeed it is doubtful if in the first four or five years shown even administrative posts paid much higher. In the last two years the maximum in cities has risen to \$5,500 augmented in one particular case by a cost-of-living bonus and a further bonus for a degree.

In one-room rural schools the maximum fell from close to \$2,000 in 1939 to less than \$1,700 in 1943. In the next two years it showed a gain. Then the maximum held for three years, to finally rise to nearly \$3,000 in 1948.

The middle half of the teachers is contained between the lower and upper quartiles and a study of this group for each type of school yields a good deal of information.

In 1939 half the teachers in one-room rural schools earned salaries between \$496 and \$727 a range of only \$231 across eight provinces. To go further, three quarters of the teachers in these schools earned less than \$727. The range was very narrow and very low on the scale. Though there has been a steady upward movement ever since, the range for this middle group of the rural teachers became even narrower in 1941 and 1942. The lower quartile has risen from \$496 in 1939 to \$1,178 in 1948 and the upper quartile from \$727 to \$1,574 but the range between the two quartiles has only increased \$165. In 1948 one-half the teachers in one-room rural schools received salaries between \$1,178 and \$1,574 and three quarters received less than the latter amount.

It will also be noted that even up to 1942 the bulk of rural salaries were on a level with the salaries of the lowest quarter of town teachers, and in this regard the rural teachers have not gained much on the improvement made in 1943.

In 1939 and 1940 the lowest quarter of rural teachers were packed within a \$100 salary range; this has gradually widened till in 1948 they are spread over some \$600.

In 1939 half the teachers in town and village schools earned salaries between \$782 and \$1,267 a range of \$485. It will be noted the lower limit of this group is \$55 above the upper limit of the corresponding group in rural schools. The range of the middle half in the town schools was more than twice that in rural schools. By 1943, i.e. in four years, the lower quartile had risen only \$100. Thereafter the gain has been about \$100 per year.

The upper quartile began to rise definitely in 1941 and between 1947 and 1948 rose almost \$300. The position of the median indicates a larger proportion of teachers were near the lower end than the upper till 1948 when the median came much nearer the centre between the two quartiles, indicating a more even distribution.

While almost all the middle half of the town teachers earned salaries below the same group in city schools in 1939, by 1948 they gained to the lower quartile of the cities.

The median for towns and villages almost doubled between 1939 and 1948. In the former year it was \$959. Definite increases did not come till after 1942 but by 1948 the median was \$1,802, having increased \$279 between 1947 and 1948.

In 1948, teachers have made their greatest dollar gains in cities. Between 1939 and 1948 the lower quartile rose \$635, the median \$711 and the upper quartile \$689. Throughout the entire period the spread between the lower and upper quartile has been over \$1,000.

Even considering the weight of the higher salaries of the large number of secondary school teachers and of teachers of long experience in cities, the differential between salaries in cities and rural schools is very marked. One quarter of rural teachers received less than \$1,178 in 1948, only \$78 more than the minimum of \$1,100 for lay teachers in city schools, and rural salary figures are not affected by the lower salaries of religious teachers. Three quarters of city teachers received over \$1,789; three quarters of rural teachers received less than \$1,574. As far as the main bodies of rural and city teachers are concerned the two scales fail to meet by over \$200.
