STATISTICAL SURVEY OF CANADIAN LIBRARIES 1929-30

Statistics have been collected for a list of 1110 Canadian libraries. These consist of (a) 640 free public and association libraries, with which are included the libraries established or supported by Women's Institutes; (b) 133 University, College and Normal School libraries and those of other educational institutions; (c) 59 government libraries, both Dominion and Provincial; (d) 59 Commercial and technical libraries, which include those of business corporations as well as those belonging to historical or scientific societies, law societies, literary and art organizations or those of a similar nature; (e) 219 other libraries, which include the Parish libraries of Quebec, the Y.M.C.A. and Y.W.C.A. libraries, and those not included in the first four groups. 
Of all the libraries listed 93.9% replied to the question card sent them. This is an improvement of 17.9% over the returns received two years ago, and the cooperation of the libraries is much appreciated. By the groups given in the summary table the returns came in as follows, the percentage being of the total listed: Free Public and Association libraries, 97.5%; University, College and Normal School libraries, 90.2%; government libraries 89.8%; business and technical libraries, 100%; others, 84.9%. The business libraries have never before been circularized, nor have the greater number of the technical libraries included in this group, consequently none appear in the list which have not sent in returns for the period immediately under consideration. All of the law libraries--which are included in this group--have reported. In addition to the libraries which have sent in a statistical report, there have been 24 which reported as closed. Of these 8 were free public or association libraries. The government library reported closed was amalgamated with a larger library, owing to a change of policy. One normal school library, that of Fredericton, N.B. was destroyed by fire but started again. Not all of the societies circularized for the first time replied. Of those that did, a number reported that they had no library, others that their libraries form special collections in some of the larger public libraries.

In Table 7 it has been attempted to give as complete statistics as possible. Consequently, when a library has not returned its question card for the year under survey, the earlier statistics that have been supplied are repeated. In every case the latest information received is used.

The main purpose in collecting this information is to secure a reliable indication of the population served by libraries in all parts of the Dominion. Now, with the 1931 census figures available, it is possible to compare the size and circulation of the libraries with the size of the community served. Usually we find the most populous areas--the cities and large towns--supplied with what may be considered almost adequate public libraries and, especially in the case of the cities, a number of educational, commercial and technical or other libraries adapted to the needs of the area served. In many cases the libraries other than public are for reference only. The smaller communities, on the <sup>other</sup> hand, maintain only small libraries as a rule, but to these districts there are usually available travelling libraries in some form, and many communities supplement their own small libraries with collections from the travelling libraries branch of their province or some other form of travelling library. In many cases there are book-collections available to the individual reader who is willing to pay the cost of postage or other means of transportation. The newest form of itinerant library adapted to Canadian usage is the library van. Two of these, operated by Acadia University, make scheduled trips through the Maritime provinces, where they are locally known as "bookmobiles". Their work is similar to the French and English "bibliobus", though they serve a wider and less populous area than the European vans.

Much information can be deduced from the statistics tabulated.

In the second table all the libraries reporting have been arranged in




23 groups according to size. Owing to the fact that "circulation" in libraries other than Free Public and Association libraries has a variety of meanings it has been omitted from all other classes in compiling this table. At a glance one can see how many libraries are in each size group and what the total contents and the total circulation in each group is. The largest libraries reported are not public libraries: one government library and two University libraries each contain over 300,000 volumes. One government library contains 250,000 volumes. Four public libraries, four educational institution libraries and three government libraries contain over 100,000 volumes each. The greater number of libraries in each class contain less than 20,000 volumes.

Of the 748 public and association libraries, including parish libraries, reporting contents and circulation, the greater number are very small, 236 of them having between 1000 and 3000 volumes and 224 of them less than 1000 volumes. Those libraries are apparently limited in patronage as well as in size, for, in the two groups 170 average less than once in circulation per volume during the year, 82 not more than once, 90 only twice and 46 only three times, while but 9 of the libraries having under 3000 volumes average 12 or more times for the circulation of each volume in the year. (Table 3)

In order to investigate the history of the libraries under consideration an endeavour has been made to secure the date of founding for as many of them as possible. With these dates as a basis the tables for contents, circulation and population (Tables 4, 5 and 6) have been compiled by four age groups or intervals. These tables, including as they do only libraries now in existence, give us a set of facts concerning the surviving libraries founded from 1 to 5, 6 to 30, 31 to 50 or more than 50 years ago. From the three age intervals, when the libraries are taken in groups of 500 volumes contents, in groups of 500 volumes circulation and in groups of 500 population according to the community which the library potentially serves, we see that there is a strong relation between the contents and the circulation of libraries of the same age. It must be explained that the sample tables do not always include the same number of libraries for more than one reason: (1) that all libraries did not report circulation as well as contents; (2) that it was not possible to discover the date of founding of all the libraries; (3) that this compilation was made before all the population figures for the census of 1931 had been compiled. It should be noted that the population figures used are all preliminary. The age groups are not all of the same size, the second group in each case covering 25 years. This 25-year age group was chosen in order to secure a set of figures regarding the survival and activity of the libraries which were established during the first quarter of the twentieth century. Standardizing the groups for inequality in length, we find that the libraries established during these 25 years and surviving in 1930 average 10.2 for every year in the group, a much greater average than for any other age group. In our circulation table (Table 5) the average is slightly less, owing to one of the reasons given above for the difference in our totals; yet the general average is almost the same as that deduced from the contents table (Table 4). When we secure our averages from the population table their general relation is much the same. It would seem probable from our tables that the circulation of a library depends considerably on the origin; that is to say, if the library has been founded because of a strong community feeling, or, in other words, with the assistance or by the activities of a considerable proportion of the people in the community, then the same impulse will tend to keep the library active. It is undoubtedly true that the libraries established during the first quarter of the century were mainly the result of some such impulse. In the early part of the century the immigration of a highly literate people to certain communities was quite heavy. From our observation we have discovered that a considerable portion of the libraries were established between 1910 and 1920. This period covers the war years. Now during the war years it is undoubtedly true that libraries were established for the men in training camps and later for those in hospitals, and at the close of the war some memorial libraries were established. These libraries in most cases were organized by such groups as the I.C.D.E., the Women's Institutes and similar bodies. Another possible reason for community interest in libraries was that at that time people were very desirous to learn more about other countries.

The libraries are arranged geographically in Table 7, each kind of library listed separately, but with those of the easternmost province given first and the others in order, proceeding westward. In each province, again, they are



arranged according to electoral district and township or parish, these placed in alphabetical order. In our earlier statistical reports we aimed to show general data by assembling the statistics in compiled tables, drawing our conclusions from the averages thus secured. Our aim in this report is to show what information is presented by a separate tabulation of each library. This tabulation was done in earlier reports but was not used as a direct statistical basis from which to draw conclusions. We have already found that the smaller the library the less the average circulation per volume (Table 2). Now we find that many of our small libraries are very old and in the older small communities. These libraries have, generally, a small circulation. Small libraries in newer communities, however, show a greater average circulation (Tables 4, 5 and 6).

#### Dominion legislation.

Several Dominion Government libraries have been created by act of Parliament. Chapter 21 of 1871 was the act by which the Library of Parliament came into existence. By later amendments the staff has been increased and improved compensation has been provided (1885, c.45; 1903, c.32). Stationery is provided by the Department of Public Printing and Stationery (1886, c.22). The Staff may be subject to the Civil Service Act (1918, c.12, s.34,35).

The Geological Survey Library was provided for in 1890 (c.11, s.7; R.S.1906, c.65, s.11) and the Mines Branch Library in 1907 (c.29, s.19; R.S.1927, c.83, s.12). The Library of the Supreme Court was placed in the hands of the Registrar under the Minister of Justice in 1888 (c.37, s.4; R.S.1906, c.139, s.17; R.S.1927, c.35, s.17). The Public Archives of Canada were established by chapter 4, 1912 (R.S.1927, c.8) by which act provision was made for the appointment of a Dominion Archivist to act as custodian of historical documents and similar valuable material.

#### Provincial Archives.

A very early law: Chapter 8 of the ordinances of Lower Canada, made provision for the restoration of ancient French records to the districts where they would be of greatest interest, especially Montreal and Three Rivers.


The public records of Nova Scotia were defined in the Revised Statutes of 1900 (c.26; R.S.1923, c.29) and in 1914 (c.6) were vested in the Province. In 1929 (c.1) they were placed in charge of a Board of Trustees of Public Archives of Nova Scotia.

In New Brunswick the public records were declared by chapter 54 of 1929, to be the King's property, and court documents and related material to be the property of the Province, which is given power to house them where they may be consulted.

The Ontario Archives Act (1923, c.20; R.S.1927, c.80) provides for all provincial documents to be placed in charge of the Bureau of Archives when not more than twenty years old, and forbids their destruction at any time without the approval of the Provincial Archivist.

#### New Legislation.

Ontario. An amendment to the Public Library Act (1929, c.66) provides for the compulsory acquisition of land for library purposes, with due compensation. The same act raises the public library rate of taxation to \$1 per capita instead of 75 cents. An amendment of 1931 (c.71, s.17) withdraws commercial circulating libraries from the supervision of the Department of Education. Saskatchewan. Chapter 35 of 1931 provides that library debentures may run for 20 instead of 10 years if the amount so raised be used for the purchase of land or the erection of buildings or improvement to buildings already in use. Alberta. The Public Libraries Amendment Act of 1931 (c.34) provides that superfluous land or buildings may be disposed of by the Library board. It also provides that the board, with the consent of the Minister of Education, may transfer its authority to a new group of persons. A further provision permits the Lieutenant Governor in Council to authorize the provision of library service in areas not as yet provided for.



Library Education.

In 1930 McGill University gave its first Bachelor of Library Science course. This is open to students holding an arts degree and is a one-year course. Eleven students registered for the first session.






