

LIST OF INSTITUTIONS OF HIGHER EDUCATION IN CANADA SHOWING ADDRESSES, CONTROL, COURSES AND AFFILIATIONS, 1953-54

This listing, included in the Dominion Bureau of Statistics biennial "Survey of Higher Education in Canada", has been brought up to date and printed in this form to provide a more convenient source of reference. The name of each institution is entered in the language (English or French) used in it as the main language of instruction. Affiliated institutions are slightly indented in the column under the listing of the parent university. The whole is designed to indicate the structure of the higher educational system in Canada.

An introductory explanation of the two systems of education in force in Canada should be made.

The French language system requires the completed classical college course (eight years after seven years of primary education, the last four years of which lead to the B.A.) as a prerequisite for entry into the various professional faculties of those universities that adhere to the classical college system.

The English language universities require specific matriculation standing, depending on the province in which they are located, for entry into university grade courses. Certain faculties, such as Medicine, require more than minimum educational standing. At present, minimum entrance requirements for admission into the faculties of Arts and Science vary from Grade XI in some provinces to Grade XIII for some of the institutions in Ontario. In general, the first degree is earned after four years of study from Junior Matriculation or three years from Senior Matriculation.

Complete information on specific entrance requirements and course content appears in the calendars of the various institutions. Copies of these can be obtained from the Registrars of the universities and colleges herein listed.
