

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INTRODUCTION

Purposes and Data Sources

Hospital statistics constitute part of the essential requirements of several federal departments as well as the various provincial departments of health and welfare. Hospital expenditures represent a significant component of the Gross Domestic Product figures. The data are further used for the administration, evaluation and planning of major provincial and federal programs as well as satisfying many of the needs of hospital administrators, researchers and large special interest groups in the community.

The Preliminary Annual Report is a subset of the data collected on the Annual Survey of Health Care Facilities - Hospitals. The objective of this survey is to provide key information on the Canadian hospital sector well in advance of the release of data from the Annual survey. Although the figures presented are preliminary they nevertheless provide a reasonably accurate portrayal of hospital costs and utilization.

The target universe is all public, private and federal hospitals operating in Canada.

Fifty-six items are collected which include data on beds, patient-days, admissions, separations, paid hours, salaries and supplies and other expenses.

Data sources for this survey are the Provincial Ministries of Health.

Beginning on April 1, 1990 there was a significant change in the method of reporting for Alberta auxiliary hospitals. On that date, in response to a Provincial move towards integration of nursing homes and auxiliary hospitals, these hospitals came under the Long Term Care Branch. The data for these facilities, as well as that for auxiliary beds formerly in the public general hospitals, are now included in the Residential Care Facilities Survey data file.

For fiscal year 1994-95, new legislation came into effect in Quebec. The *Loi sur les services de santé et les services sociaux* amalgamated the hospital operational category "Centres hospitaliers de soins de longue durée" with the residential care facility category "Centres d'accueil d'hébergement" into one new category, "Centres d'hébergement et de soins de longue durée." The data for these facilities are now included in the Residential Care Facilities Survey for 1994-95.

But et sources de données

La statistique hospitalière constitue un élément d'information essentiel à plusieurs ministères fédéraux et aux ministères provinciaux de la santé et du bien-être. Les dépenses des hôpitaux sont une importante composante du produit intérieur brut. Les données servent également à l'administration, à l'évaluation et à la planification des principaux programmes provinciaux et fédéraux et répondent à un bon nombre de besoins des directeurs des hôpitaux, des chercheurs et des grands groupes d'intérêts spéciaux de la collectivité.

Le Rapport annuel préliminaire renferme un sous-ensemble des données réunies à l'aide du Rapport annuel des établissements de santé - hôpitaux. Le but de cette enquête est de produire des renseignements clés sur le secteur hospitalier canadien bien avant la diffusion des données de l'enquête annuelle. Bien que les chiffres présentés soient provisoires, ils fournissent néanmoins un portrait assez précis du coût et de l'utilisation des hôpitaux.

L'univers visé est constitué de l'ensemble des hôpitaux publics, privés et fédéraux en activité au Canada.

Cinquante-six éléments d'information sont recueillis, dont des données sur les lits, les journées d'hospitalisation, les admissions, les radiations, les heures rémunérées, les traitements et les fournitures et autres dépenses.

Les sources de données pour l'enquête sont les ministères provinciaux de la santé.

À partir du 1^{er} avril 1990, une importante modification a été apportée à la méthode de déclaration utilisée pour les hôpitaux auxiliaires de l'Alberta. Depuis cette date, en raison du mouvement provincial d'intégration des foyers de soins infirmiers et des hôpitaux auxiliaires, ces derniers relèvent de la Direction des soins de longue durée. Les données concernant ces hôpitaux, ainsi que celles sur les lits auxiliaires se trouvant auparavant dans les hôpitaux généraux publics, sont intégrées au fichier de données du Rapport des établissements de soins pour bénéficiaires internes.

Pour l'année financière 1994-1995, une nouvelle loi a été mise sur pied au Québec. La *Loi sur les services de santé et les services sociaux* a amalgamé l'affectation des hôpitaux "Centres hospitaliers de soins de longue durée" avec celle des établissements de soins pour bénéficiaires internes "Centres d'accueil d'hébergement" dans une nouvelle affectation "Centres d'hébergement et de soins de longue durée." Les données pour cette dernière affectation sont maintenant incorporées dans le Rapport des établissements de soins pour bénéficiaires internes pour l'année financière 1994-1995.

This publication "Hospital Statistics: Preliminary Annual Report, 1994-95" marks the end of the data series which used the Canadian Hospital Accounting Manual (CHAM) guidelines. Starting with fiscal year 1995-96, the hospital data will follow the Management Information Systems (MIS) accounting guidelines.

Cette publication "La statistique hospitalière: Rapport annuel préliminaire 1994-1995" indique la fin de la série de données utilisant le Manuel de comptabilité des hôpitaux du Canada (MCHC). À partir de l'année financière 1995-1996, les données hospitalières suivront le guide des Systèmes d'information de gestion (SIG).

Methodology

Data Collection

Data for the hospitals are requested from the provincial ministries of health, or responsible federal departments by means of a one page questionnaire. In most instances the ministry will complete the questionnaire using administrative data, although occasionally it is forwarded to a hospital for completion.

Data Definition

The data collected adheres to the Instructions and Definitions Parts I and II developed for the reporting of hospitals to Statistics Canada.

The definitions of terms for the hospital database are as follows:

Hospital

Is defined as an institution where patients are accommodated on the basis of medical need and are provided with continuing medical care and supporting diagnostic and therapeutic services, and which is licensed or approved as a hospital by a provincial government, or is operated by the Government of Canada. This definition includes psychiatric institutions.

Type of Hospital

Public (including voluntary, provincial and municipal). Applies to a hospital recognized by the province as a "public hospital". Such a hospital generally is not operated for profit.

Proprietary. Applies to a hospital owned by an individual or by a private organization, operated for a profit and recognized by the province as a "proprietary hospital".

Federal. Applies to a hospital owned by a department or agency of the Government of Canada and operated on a non-profit basis.

Type of Unit

Short-term units - Adults and children. Are those inpatient units provided for patients who, at the time of admission, require diagnostic and therapeutic services and/or skilled nursing care and medical attention.

Long-term units - Adults and children. Are those inpatient units provided for patients who, at the time of admission, require regular medical assessment and continuing nursing care.

Méthodologie

Collecte des données

Les données sur les hôpitaux sont obtenues des ministères provinciaux de la santé ou des ministères fédéraux responsables, au moyen d'un questionnaire d'une page. Dans la plupart des cas, le ministère remplit le questionnaire à l'aide des données administratives mais il arrive parfois que le questionnaire soit transmis à l'hôpital pour que celui-ci le remplisse.

Définition des données

Les données réunies sont conformes aux Directives et définitions, 1^{re} et 2^e parties, élaborées en vue de la déclaration que fournissent les hôpitaux à Statistique Canada.

Les définitions utilisées pour la base de données sur les hôpitaux sont les suivantes:

Hôpital

Par définition, un hôpital est un établissement qui reçoit des personnes requérant des soins médicaux et leur dispense de façon continue ces soins ainsi que des services diagnostiques et thérapeutiques d'appoint, et qui est enregistré ou reconnu comme hôpital par une province ou qui est administré par le gouvernement du Canada. Cette définition englobe les établissements psychiatriques.

Genre d'hôpital

Hôpital public (s'applique aux hôpitaux sans but lucratif, aux hôpitaux provinciaux et aux hôpitaux municipaux). Hôpital reconnu par la province comme "public". Un tel hôpital ne vise ordinairement pas à réaliser des bénéfices.

Hôpital privé à but lucratif. Cette définition s'applique aux hôpitaux reconnus comme "privés à but lucratif"; il s'agit des hôpitaux qui appartiennent aux particuliers ou aux organismes privés et qui sont exploités en vue de réaliser des bénéfices.

Hôpital fédéral. Hôpital appartenant à un ministère ou un organisme du gouvernement du Canada et ne visant pas à réaliser des bénéfices.

Genre d'unité

Unités de soins de courte durée - Adultes et enfants. Il s'agit des unités d'hospitalisation où sont traités les malades dont l'état, au moment de leur admission, requiert des services diagnostiques et thérapeutiques et (ou) des soins infirmiers spécialisés et une surveillance médicale.

Unités de soins de longue durée - Adultes et enfants. S'applique aux unités d'hospitalisation où sont traités les malades dont l'état, au moment de leur admission, requiert des soins médicaux et infirmiers constants.

Type of Service**General**

No long-term units. Refers to a hospital which provides primarily for the diagnosis and short-term treatment of patients for a wide range of diseases or injuries. The services of a general hospital are not restricted to a specific age group or sex.

With long-term units. Refers to a general hospital with a group of beds or rooms or a separate wing or building for long-term care, which is recognized as a distinct and separate treatment unit of the hospital. Admission normally requires formal admission procedures even when a patient is transferred from another part of the same hospital.

Teaching hospital. Applies to a hospital which provides medical education programs, approved by the appropriate authorities, for the major clinical instruction in at least the medical disciplines of internal medicine and general surgery to undergraduate medical students in their final two years.

Allied Special Hospitals

Specialty. Applies to a hospital which provides primarily for the diagnosis and short-term treatment of patients for a limited range of diseases or injuries, or a broad range of services to a specific age group.

Pediatric. Applies to a hospital which provides for the diagnosis and short-term treatment of pediatric patients, generally 14 years of age and under.

Psychiatric. Applies to a hospital which provides for the diagnosis and short-term treatment of patients with psychiatric conditions.

Other. Applies to a cancer hospital, cardiology hospital or institute, maternity hospital, neurological institute, orthopedic hospital, etc.

Rehabilitation (including convalescent). Applies to a hospital which provides primarily for the continuing assessment and treatment of patients whose condition is expected to improve significantly through the provision of physical medicine and other rehabilitative services.

Extended care (including chronic). Applies to a hospital which provides primarily for the continuing treatment of patients with long-term illness or with a low potential for recovery and who require regular medical assessment and continuing nursing care.

Genre de service**Hôpital général**

Sans unités de soins de longue durée. Hôpital qui assure principalement le diagnostic et le traitement à court terme d'une grande variété d'affections et de traumatismes, sans distinction d'âge et de sexe.

Avec unités de soins de longue durée. Hôpital général comprenant, pour les soins de longue durée, un groupe de lits ou de chambres ou encore une aile ou un bâtiment séparé qui est considéré comme quartier de traitement distinct. Pour y être admis, il faut en général remplir les formalités de demande d'admission, même s'il s'agit d'un transfert d'un malade d'un autre quartier du même hôpital.

Hôpital d'enseignement. Hôpital qui offre des programmes d'enseignement, dûment approuvés par les autorités compétentes, pour la formation clinique principale des étudiants effectuant leurs deux dernières années d'étude dans des disciplines médicales, dont la médecine interne et la chirurgie générale.

Hôpitaux spéciaux divers

Hôpital spécialisé. Hôpital qui assure principalement le diagnostic et le traitement à court terme d'un nombre restreint de maladies ou de traumatismes, ou qui fournit un vaste éventail de services à des personnes d'un groupe d'âge particulier.

Hôpital pédiatrique. Hôpital qui se spécialise dans le diagnostic et le traitement à court terme des maladies chez les enfants, âgés généralement de 14 ans ou moins.

Hôpital psychiatrique. Hôpital qui assure le diagnostic et le traitement à court terme de malades souffrant de troubles psychiatriques.

Autres hôpitaux. Centre anticancéreux, hôpital ou institut de cardiologie, maternité, institut neurologique, hôpital orthopédique, etc.

Hôpital de réadaptation (convalescence comprise). Hôpital qui assure principalement la surveillance constante et le traitement de malades dont l'état est censé s'améliorer considérablement à la suite de soins de physiothérapie et de réadaptation.

Hôpital de soins prolongés (maladies chroniques comprises). Hôpital qui dispense principalement des traitements constants aux personnes atteintes de maladies de longue durée ou à celles dont les chances de guérison sont faibles et qui requièrent des soins médicaux et infirmiers constants.

Psychiatric (long term). Applies to a hospital which provides primarily for the continuing assessment and long-term treatment of patients with psychiatric conditions.

Other. Applies to Nursing Stations and Out-post Hospitals.

Ownership and Operation

The ownership and operation of the hospital are separate aspects of hospital functioning.

Ownership. The owner of the hospital is the person, group of persons, agency, or corporate body who is the registered owner according to the deed.

Operation. Refers to the person, group of persons, agency or corporate body which bears the day to day responsibility for ensuring that the hospital is able to function and provide services.

Voluntary. Applies to a hospital owned and/or operated by a non-governmental organization.

Lay Corporation. Applies to a voluntary hospital owned and/or operated by a voluntary lay group.

Religious Organization. Applies to a voluntary hospital owned and/or operated by a religious organization.

Red Cross. Applies to a voluntary hospital owned and/or operated by the Canadian Red Cross Society or one of its provincial divisions.

Municipal (union or hospital district). Applies to a hospital owned and/or operated by a city, county, municipality, or other municipal government, or by a union or combination of municipal governments, or by a district or other body which is empowered to levy taxes or to otherwise operate after the fashion of a municipality. Municipal operation, as well as ownership, would be indicated if the members of the governing body of the hospital are appointed, elected or otherwise controlled by the municipal body or electorate.

Provincial. Applies to a hospital owned and/or operated by a branch, division, agency, or department of a provincial or territorial government.

Federal. Applies to a hospital owned and/or operated by a department or agency of the Government of Canada and operated on a nonprofit basis. Operation will generally be by one of the following agencies: Veterans' Affairs, Health Canada, National Defence and Solicitor General Canada.

Hôpital psychiatrique (soins prolongés). Hôpital qui assure principalement l'évaluation et le traitement suivi de malades atteints de troubles psychiatriques.

Autres. S'applique aux postes infirmiers et aux hôpitaux éloignés.

Propriété et gestion

La propriété et la gestion de l'hôpital sont deux aspects distincts de son fonctionnement.

Propriété. Le propriétaire de l'hôpital est la personne, le groupe de personnes, l'organisme ou la personne morale qui est le propriétaire enregistré selon l'acte de propriété.

Gestion. Il s'agit de la personne, du groupe de personnes, de l'organisme ou de la personne morale qui est chargé, de jour en jour, de s'assurer que l'hôpital est en mesure d'exercer son activité et de fournir les services.

Organisme sans but lucratif. Hôpital sans but lucratif que possède et (ou) dirige un organisme non gouvernemental.

Société laïque. Hôpital sans but lucratif que possède et (ou) dirige un groupe de bénévoles laïques.

Organisme religieux. Hôpital sans but lucratif que possède et (ou) dirige un organisme religieux.

Croix-Rouge. Hôpital sans but lucratif que possède et (ou) dirige la Société canadienne de la Croix-Rouge ou une de ses divisions provinciales.

Municipalité (région ou district). Hôpital sans but lucratif que possède et (ou) dirige une ville, un village, un comté, une municipalité ou toute autre administration municipale, une association de municipalités, un district ou toute autre personne morale qui est autorisé à lever des impôts ou à agir comme municipalité. On peut considérer que la propriété et la gestion font partie du domaine municipal si les membres du conseil d'administration de l'hôpital sont nommés ou élus par l'autorité municipale ou le corps électoral ou encore leur est soumis d'une autre manière.

Gouvernement provincial. Hôpital sans but lucratif que possède et (ou) dirige une direction, une division, un organisme ou un ministère d'un gouvernement provincial ou territorial.

Gouvernement fédéral. Hôpital sans but lucratif que possède et (ou) dirige un ministère ou un organisme du gouvernement du Canada. La gestion est généralement confiée à un des organismes suivants: Affaires des anciens combattants, Santé Canada, Défense nationale ou Solliciteur général Canada.

Proprietary. Applies to a hospital owned and/or operated by an individual or by a private organization and operated for a profit.

Utilization

Approved bed complement. The number of beds and cribs (or bassinets for newborns), approved for the hospital, or a unit of the hospital, as at year-end of the reporting year, by the provincial authorities.

Beds staffed and in operation. The distribution of beds and cribs (or bassinets for newborn), as at the year-end of the reporting year, that are actually available for patient accommodation, with staff available to provide the required level and type of care, whether or not actually occupied by a patient at that time.

Inpatient. A person who has been admitted to a hospital for medical and hospital services and who has been assigned an inpatient bed or bassinet.

Adults and children. All inpatients except newborns.

Newborn. An infant liveborn in the hospital or admitted with the mother who was admitted for maternity services.

Admission. The official acceptance into a hospital of a patient (including an infant born alive in the hospital) who requires medical and hospital services including room and board.

Discharge. The official departure from the hospital or from a provincially recognized unit of the hospital of a live inpatient.

Death. The cessation of life of an inpatient after admission and before discharge.

Separation. The discharge or death of an inpatient.

Patient-day. The period of service to an inpatient between the census-taking hours on two successive days; the day of admission is counted as a patient-day but the day of separation is not.

Operating Expense

The cost, on an accrual basis of operating and maintaining the hospital during the year.

Gross salaries and wages including all medical staff remuneration. These are distributed to two sub-categories:

Privé à but lucratif. Hôpital que possède et (ou) exploite un particulier ou un organisme privé en vue de réaliser des profits.

Utilisation

Lits approuvés. Le nombre de lits ou de berceaux (pour les nouveau-nés) qui, à la fin de l'année visée par le rapport, étaient approuvés par les autorités provinciales dans le cas de l'hôpital ou d'unité de l'hôpital.

Lits dressés, dotés en personnel et utilisés. Le nombre de lits ou de berceaux (pour les nouveau-nés) qui, à la fin de l'année visée par le rapport, étaient réellement à la disposition des malades (qu'ils soient occupés ou non à cette date) et qui étaient dotés du personnel pouvant fournir des soins de la qualité et du type voulus.

Hospitalisé. Personne admise à l'hôpital pour y recevoir des soins médicaux et hospitaliers et à laquelle on a affecté un lit ou un berceau.

Adultes et enfants. Tous les hospitalisés sauf les nouveau-nés.

Nouveau-né. Enfant né vivant à l'hôpital ou entré avec sa mère admise pour des soins obstétricaux.

Admission. Acceptation officielle par l'hôpital d'un malade (y compris un bébé né vivant à l'hôpital) requérant des soins médicaux et hospitaliers, y compris la chambre et les repas.

Sortie. Départ officiel de l'hôpital, ou d'une unité reconnue par la province, d'un malade vivant.

Décès. Mort d'un hospitalisé après son admission et avant sa sortie.

Radiation. Sortie ou décès d'un hospitalisé.

Journée d'hospitalisation. Période de soins fournis à un hospitalisé entre les heures du recensement quotidien sur deux jours consécutifs; le jour de l'admission compte comme journée d'hospitalisation, mais non le jour de la radiation.

Dépenses d'exploitation

Les dépenses d'exploitation et d'entretien de l'hôpital au cours de l'année, établies d'après la comptabilité d'exercice.

Rémunération brute, y compris la rémunération du personnel médical. Est divisée en deux sous-catégories:

Medical staff. Includes all types of hospital remuneration earned during the year by paid medical staff, i.e. salaries, wages, fees, contract rates, honorarium, etc.

Other gross salaries and wages. Includes gross salaries and wages earned during the year by all other staff including non-medical teaching staff and regular employees involved in extramural or on-the-job training.

Employee benefits. The facility's contribution to the cost of various fringe benefits provided to its employees. These do not include perquisites such as room and board provided for employees, which are a part of salaries and wages.

Supplies and other expenses. These are distributed to three sub-categories:

Supplies and other expenses (excluding medical and surgical supplies and drugs). Includes all of the hospital's operating expenses other than gross salaries and wages and excluding the cost of medical and surgical supplies, drugs and employee benefits.

Medical and surgical supplies. Items used in the treatment and examination of patients such as sutures, dressings, clinical thermometers, sterile supplies, catheters, needles and syringes, etc.

Drugs. All drugs, as well as medicines, anesthetic gases, oxygen and other medical gases, intravenous solutions, etc.

Data Quality

The collection and processing of data takes place in the nine month period from April to December. The response rate to this survey has always been over 80% covering over 90% of the beds. The response rate for Public hospitals alone is generally higher at about 90%.

Preliminary data are subject to change upon the release of data from the Hospital Annual Survey. Since financial data are not audited there tends to be incomplete reporting from some hospitals.

Hospitals do not always provide complete information. For example some may not report expenditures while others will give a total without a breakdown. As missing data are not imputed, expenditures may not be comparable from year to year.

Rémunération du personnel médical. Comprend tous les genres de rémunération versée par l'hôpital et gagnée au cours de l'année par le personnel médical, c.-à-d. traitements, salaires, honoraires, gains provenant d'un contrat, etc.

Autre rémunération brute. Comprend la rémunération brute gagnée durant l'année par tous les autres membres du personnel, y compris le personnel enseignant non médical et les employés permanents recevant une formation à l'extérieur ou une formation en cours d'emploi.

Avantages sociaux. Contribution de l'hôpital aux avantages sociaux dont bénéficient les employés. Ne comprennent pas les avantages indirects, tels le logement et la nourriture, qui sont intégrés aux traitements et salaires.

Fournitures et autres dépenses. Sont divisées en trois sous-catégories:

Fournitures et autres dépenses (sauf les fournitures médicales et chirurgicales, et les médicaments). Comprend toutes les dépenses d'exploitation de l'hôpital autres que la rémunération brute, le coût des fournitures médicales et chirurgicales, les médicaments et les avantages sociaux.

Fournitures médicales et chirurgicales. Articles utilisés pour le traitement et l'examen des malades, comme les fils de suture, les pansements, les thermomètres médicaux, les articles stériles, les cathéters, les aiguilles et les seringues, etc.

Médicaments. Tous les médicaments ainsi que les remèdes, les gaz anesthésiques, l'oxygène et autres gaz médicaux, les solutions intraveineuses, etc.

Qualité des données

La collecte et le traitement des données se déroulent durant la période de neuf mois comprise entre avril à décembre. Le taux de réponse à l'enquête s'est toujours situé à plus de 80% et représente plus de 90% des lits. Celui des hôpitaux publics seulement est en général supérieur (environ 90%).

Les données provisoires peuvent être modifiées à la sortie des données de l'enquête annuelle sur les hôpitaux. Puisque les données financières ne sont pas vérifiées, il arrive que les déclarations de certains hôpitaux soient incomplètes.

Les hôpitaux ne fournissent pas toujours des renseignements complets. Par exemple, certains ne déclareront pas leurs dépenses alors que d'autres four-niront un total sans ventilation. Comme il n'y a pas d'imputation pour les données manquantes, les dépenses pourront ne pas être comparables d'une année à l'autre.

Private and Federal hospitals, which together make up 8% of all hospitals but only 2% of all beds, are not required to report financial information on this survey. The only data available for these hospitals are on beds and hospital utilization. Consequently, tables referring to expenditures represent data from public hospitals only. For this report, no attempt was made to adjust the data to account for hospitals not responding to the survey or for item non-response.

Hospital data are used by other Statistics Canada divisions and government departments such as Input-Output Division, Labour Division and Health Canada. Many of these departments will use their own calculations to adjust for non-response so care should be taken if comparing their final output to reported data.

The reporting form was revised for 1987-88. More detailed information was collected on the new form giving a breakdown of beds, patient days, total days stay, admissions and separations for both short and long term units as well as newborn. The old form collected only the totals for all units combined. Additional data were collected on paid hours, salaries and supplies, providing a breakdown for nursing, diagnostic and therapeutic, special research, educational programs and the administrative and support category.

Les hôpitaux privés et fédéraux, qui ensemble représentent 8% de tous les hôpitaux mais seulement 2% des lits dans les hôpitaux, n'ont pas à déclarer les renseignements financiers. Les seules données fournies par ces hôpitaux sont celles relatives aux lits et à l'utilisation des hôpitaux. En conséquence, les tableaux sur les dépenses comprennent uniquement les données des hôpitaux publics. Aux fins du rapport, aucun rajustement des données en vue de rendre compte d'une non-réponse totale ou partielle n'est réalisé.

Les données sur les hôpitaux servent à d'autres divisions de Statistique Canada, comme la Division des entrées-sorties et la Division du travail, et aux ministères, entre autres Santé Canada. Bon nombre de ministères se serviront de leurs propres calculs de rajustement des données pour tenir compte de la non-réponse: il faut donc faire preuve de prudence lorsque l'on compare leur produit final aux données déclarées.

Le nouveau formulaire recueille des renseignements plus détaillés, dont une ventilation des lits, des journées d'hospitalisation, de la durée totale de l'hospitalisation, des admissions et des radiations, tant pour les unités des soins de longue durée que ceux de courte durée, ainsi que des nouveau-nés. L'ancien formulaire réunissait seulement les totaux pour l'ensemble des unités. Des données supplémentaires sont également réunies sur les heures rémunérées, la rémunération et les fournitures, y compris une ventilation pour les soins infirmiers, diagnostiques et thérapeutiques, les recherches spéciales, les programmes d'enseignement et la catégorie de l'administration et du soutien.
