REGISTRATIONS OF BIRTHS, DEATHS AND MARRIAGES, MOVEMBER, 1930.

The Dominion Bureau of Statistics issues to-day the number of registrations of births, deaths and marriages during the month of November, 1930 in cities with a population of 10,000 at the last Census. Stillbirths are registered both as births and deaths.

As compared with October, births registered in November showed a decrease of 11 per cent. In the Maritime Provinces the decline was $10\frac{1}{2}$ per cent, in Quebec 4 per cent, in Ontario 16 per cent, in the Prairie Provinces $12\frac{1}{2}$ per cent and in British Columbia $10\frac{1}{2}$ per cent.

Deaths registered in these cities in November numbered 9 per cent less than in the preceding month. In the Maritime Provinces there was an increase of 8 per cent, but Quebec showed a reduction of 5 per cent, Ontario of $11\frac{1}{2}$ per cent, the Prairie Provinces of 14 per cent and British Columbia of $15\frac{1}{2}$ per cent.

The number of marriages registered in November was less by 19 per cent than in October. In the Prairie Provinces there was a slight increase, amounting to only 1 per cent, but the other sections of the country registered declines, amounting to $9\frac{1}{3}$ per cent in the Maritime Provinces, $35\frac{1}{3}$ per cent in Quebec, $21\frac{1}{2}$ per cent in Ontario and 27 per cent in British Columbia.
