REGISTRATIONS OF BIRTHS, DEATHS AND MARRIAGES, DECEMBER, 1930.

The Dominion Bureau of Statistics issues to-day the number of registrations of births, deaths and marriages during the month of December, 1930 in cities with a population of 10,000 at the last Census. Stillbirths are registered both as births and deaths.

As compared with November, births registered in December showed an increase of  $4\frac{1}{2}$  per cent. In the Maritime Provinces the increase was 20 per cent, in Ontario 9 per cent and in the Prairie Provinces 5 per cent. Quebec showed a decline of  $2\frac{1}{2}$  per cent and British Columbia of 1 per cent.

Deaths registered in these cities in December numbered  $8\frac{1}{2}$  per cent more than in the preceding month. In the Maritime Provinces there was a reduction of 7 per cent, but Quebec showed an increase of 9 per cent, Ontario 8 per cent, the Prairie Provinces 15 per cent and British Columbia 17 per cent.

The number of marriages registered in December was less by  $12\frac{1}{2}$  per cent than in November. In Quebec there was an increase of 7 per cent and in British Columbia  $13\frac{1}{2}$  per cent, but the other Sections of the country registered declines, amounting to 11 per cent in the Maritime Provinces,  $15\frac{1}{2}$  per cent in Ontario and  $25\frac{1}{2}$  per cent in the Prairie Provinces.
