REGISTRATIONS OF BIRTHS, DEATHS AND MARRIAGES, APRIL, 1930.

The Dominion Bureau of Statistics issues to-day the number of registrations of births, deaths and marriages during the month of April, 1930 in cities with a population of 10,000 at the last Census. Stillbirths are registered both as births and deaths.

These figures are based on monthly reports furnished either by the Provincial Departments or by city Registration Offices.

Except where otherwise specified, the registrations include all births, deaths and marriages which occurred in a given city.

As compared with March, births registered in April in the cities listed showed a decrease of 1.3 per cent. In the Maritime Provinces there was a decrease of 4.3 per cent, in Quebec 9 per cent and in the Prairie Provinces 1.4 per cent. Ontario birth registrations increased by 3.2 per cent and those of British Columbia by 13.7 per cent.

Deaths registered in April in these cities also numbered 1.3 per cent less than in March. The Maritime Provinces, the Prairie Provinces and British Columbia showed decreases of 8.6 per cent, 9.5 per cent and 19 per cent respectively. On the other hand death registrations in Quebec in April exceeded those of March by 4.7 per cent while there was a slight increase of about 1 per cent in Ontario.

Marriages registered in April showed an increase of 18.2 per cent over the preceding month. There was a decline of 5 per cent in the Maritime Provinces but increases in the remaining subdivisions of the country, amounting to 37 per cent in Quebec, 24.4 per cent in Ontario, 2.3 per cent in the Prairie Provinces and 9.7 per cent in British Columbia.
