REGISTRATIONS OF BIRTHS, DEATHS AND MARRIAGES, JUNE, 1930

The Dominion Bureau of Statistics issues to-day the number of registrations of births, deaths and marriages during the month of June, 1930 in cities with a population of 10,000 at the last Census. Stillbirths are registered both as births and deaths.

As compared with May, births registered in June in the cities listed showed a decrease of almost 8 per cent. In the Maritime Provinces the decline was 1 per cent, in Quebec 5 per cent, in Ontario 10 per cent, in the Prairie Provinces 11 per cent and in British Columbia 9 per cent.

Deaths registered in these cities in June numbered 8 per cent less than in May. The decrease amounted to 18 per cent in the Maritime Provinces, 4 per cent in Quebec, 10 per cent in Ontario, 9 per cent in the Prairie Provinces and 5 per cent in British Columbia.

The popularity of June as a marriage month is shown by an increase of 83½ per cent in the number of marriages registered during the month as compared with the preceding month. In the Maritime Provinces the increase was 68 per cent, in Quebec 140 per cent, in Ontario 83 per cent, in the Prairie Provinces 42 per cent and in British Columbia 66 per cent.
