REGISTRATIONS OF BIRTHS, DEATHS AND MARRIAGES, JULY, 1930.

The Dominion Bureau of Statistics issues to-day the number of registrations of births, deaths and marriages during the month of July, 1930 in cities with a population of 10,000 at the last Census. Stillbirths are registered both as births and deaths.

As compared with June, births registered in July in the cities listed showed an increase of some 5½ per cent. In the Maritime Provinces there was a decline of 3 per cent, and in Quebec the difference was negligible, but Ontario showed an increase of 5 per cent, the Prairie Provinces of 2 per cent and British Columbia of 9 per cent.

Deaths registered in these cities in July numbered 2 per cent less than in June. The Maritime Provinces showed an increase of 5 per cent and the Prairie Provinces of 26 per cent, but in Quebec there was a reduction of 7½ per cent, in Ontario of 6 per cent and in British Columbia of 3 per cent.

There was a decline of 27 per cent in the number of marriages registered in July as compared with the preceding month. In the Maritime Provinces the decrease was 33 per cent, in Quebec 41 per cent, in Ontario 26 per cent, in the Prairie Provinces 1 per cent and in British Columbia 32 per cent.
