REGISTRATIONS OF BIRTHS, DEATHS AND MARRIAGES, AUGUST, 1930

The Dominion Bureau of Statistics issues to-day the number of registrations of births, deaths and marriages during the month of August, 1930 in cities with a population of 10,000 at the last Census. Stillbirths are registered both as births and deaths.

As compared with July, births registered in August in the cities listed showed a slight decrease of a little more than one per cent. In the Maritime Provinces there was an increase of 15 per cent and in Quebec of 8 per cent, but in Ontario the number declined by 3 per cent, in the Prairie Provinces by 16 per cent and in British Columbia by 9½ per cent.

Deaths registered in these cities in August numbered one per cent more than in July. The Maritime Provinces showed an increase of 13 per cent and Quebec of 17 per cent. In Ontario there was a reduction of 8 per cent, in the Prairie Provinces of 15 per cent and in British Columbia of 2 per cent.

The number of marriages registered in August was greater by 3 per cent than in the preceding month. In the Maritime Provinces the increase was 20 per cent, in Quebec 24 per cent and in British Columbia 9 per cent. In Ontario there was a decrease of 5 per cent and in the Prairie Provinces of 10 per cent.
