REGISTRATIONS OF BIRTHS, DEATHS AND MARRIAGES, SEPTEMBER, 1930

The Dominion Bureau of Statistics issues to-day the number of registrations of births, deaths and marriages during the month of September, 1930 in cities with a population of 10,000 at the last Census. Stillbirths are registered both as births and deaths.

As compared with August, births registered in September in the cities listed showed a decrease of 6 per cent. The decline amounted to 12 per cent in the Maritime Provinces and $18\frac{1}{2}$ per cent in Quebec. The Ontario figure showed hardly any change, and in the Prairie Provinces and British Columbia there were increases of 5 per cent and 11 per cent respectively.

Deaths registered in these cities in September numbered 4 per cent more than in the preceding month. The Maritime Provinces showed a reduction of $4\frac{1}{2}$ per cent and Quebec 6 per cent, but deaths were more numerous by 18 per cent in Ontario and by $3\frac{1}{2}$ per cent in the Prairie Provinces. The figure for British Columbia showed only a very slight change.

The number of marriages registered in September was greater by 9 per cent than in August. In the Maritime Provinces the increase was 11 per cent, in Ontario 27 per cent and in the Prairie Provinces 8 per cent. In Quebec there was a decrease of 13 per cent and in British Columbia of $5\frac{1}{2}$ per cent.
