REGISTRATIONS OF BIRTHS, DEATHS AND MARRIAGES, SEFTEMBER, 1930

The Dominion Bureau of Statistics issues to-day the number of registrations of births, deaths and marriages during the month of September, 1930 in cities with a population of 10,000 at the last Census. Stillbirths are registered both as births and deaths.

As compared with August, births registered in September in the cities listed showed a decrease of 6 per cent. The decline amounted to 12 per cent in the Maritime Provinces and 182 per cent in Quebec. The Ontario figure showed hardly any change, and in the Prairie Provinces and British Columbia there were increases of 5 per cent and 11 per cent respectively.

Deaths registered in these cities in September numbered 4 per cent more than in the preceding month. The Maritime Provinces showed a reduction of 41 per cent and Quebec 6 per cent, but deaths were more numerous by 18 per cent in Ontario and by 32 per cent in the Prairie Provinces. The figure for British Columbia showed only a very slight change.

The number of marriages registered in September was greater by 9 per cent than in August. In the Maritime Provinces the increase was 11 per cent, in Ontario 27 per cent and in the Prairie Provinces 8 per cent. In Quebec there was a decrease of 13 per cent and in British Columbia of 52 per cent.
