REGISTRATIONS OF BIRTHS, DEATHS AND MARRIAGES, MARCH, 1931.

The Dominion Bureau of Statistics issues to-day the number of registrations of births, deaths and marriages during the month of March, 1931 in cities with a population of 10,000 and over at the last Census. Stillbirths are registered both as births and deaths.

Births registered in these cities in March numbered 7,436 as compared with 7,684 in March of last year, a decline of 3 per cent. Deaths in the month under review amounted to 4,168 as against 4,407 in the corresponding month of last year, thus showing a reduction of $5\frac{1}{2}$ per cent. There were 1,556 marriages in the month, making a decrease of $21\frac{1}{2}$ per cent from March of last year, when 2,001 marriages were registered.

Births registered during the three months January-March totalled 21,076, against

Births registered during the three months January-March totalled 21,076, against 21,454 in January-March last year, a falling off of 2 per cent. There were 12,364 deaths in the three months, showing a reduction of 2 per cent from the figure for the corresponding months of last year, 12,603. Marriages during the three months' period numbered only 5,608 as compared with 6,416 in the corresponding months of last year. This constituted a decline of $12\frac{1}{2}$ per cent.
