REGISTRATIONS OF BIRTHS, DEATHS AND MARRIAGES, MAY, 1931.

The Dominion Bureau of Statistics issues today the number of registrations of births, deaths and marriages during the month of May, 1931, in cities with a population of 10,000 and over at the last census. Stillbirths are registered both as births and deaths.

Births registered in these cities in May numbered 7,461, deaths 3,746 and marriages 2,149, as compared with 7,957 births, 4,034 deaths and 2,363 marriages in May last year, giving a reduction of 6 percent in births, 7 percent in deaths and 9 percent in marriages.

The five months January - May show 35,964 births, 20,003 deaths and 10,082 marriages registered, as against 36,998 births, 20,988 deaths and 11,145 marriages in the same period last year, a decrease of 3 percent in births, 4½ per cent in deaths and 9½ percent in marriages.
