REGISTRATION OF BIRTHS, DEATHS AND MARRIAGES, JUNE, 1931.

The Dominion Bureau of Statistics issues today the number of registrations of births, deaths and marriages during the month of June, 1931, in cities with a population of 10,000 and over at the last census. Stillbirths are registered both as births and deaths.

Births registered in these cities in June numbered 7,457, deaths 3,369 and marriages 3,706, as compared with 7,258 births, 3,644 deaths and 4,300 marriages in June last year, giving an increase of $2\frac{1}{2}$ percent in births, and decreases of $7\frac{1}{2}$ percent and 1^{14} percent in deaths and marriages respectively.

The six months January - June show 43,421 births, 25,461 deaths and 13,788 marriages registered, as against 44,256 births, 24,632 deaths and 15,445 marriages in the same period last year, a decrease of 2 percent in births, an increase of 32 percent in deaths and a decrease of $10\frac{1}{2}$ percent in marriages.
