REGISTRATION OF BIRTHS, DEATHS AND MARRIAGES, SEPTEMBER, 1931.

The Dominion Bureau of Statistics issues today the number of registrations of births, deaths and marriages during the month of September, 1931, in 53 cities of Canada. Stillbirths are registered both as births and deaths.

Births registered in these cities in September numbered 7,136, deaths 3,700 and marriages 3,207, as compared with 7,179 births 3,730 deaths and 3,519 marriages in September last year, giving a decrease of 1 per cent in births, 8 per cent in deaths, and 9 per cent in marriages.

The nine months January - September show 66,116 births, 34,697 deaths and 22,684 marriages registered, as against 66,874 births, 35,735 deaths and 25,411 marriages during the corresponding period last year, a decrease of 1 per cent in births, 3 per cent in deaths and 11 per cent in marriages.
